

IMBA Class of 2025 Graduation Requirements

A total of 37.5 credits must be completed to fulfill graduation requirements for the IMBA program. These 37.5 credits are broken down into:

1. Foundation Courses (12 credits) – Required

 Successful completion of all foundation courses is required. Minimal passing grade of each course is 60% (P)

2. Advanced Courses (19.5 credits)

- Advanced Courses credits can be replaced by the credits earned outside of the IMBA Program* upon approval, and upon successful completion of 75% of Foundation Courses
 - *Please refer to the policy "<u>Credits Earned Outside of the Degree Program</u>" for more details about the credits earned outside of the IMBA Program

3. Residencies (7.5 credits) - Required

- 100% attendance is required at 3 Residencies which include
 - 5-day Opening Residency (Opening Program + BASM 501)
 - 2-week Vancouver Residency (BA 514)
 - o 5-day Capstone Residency (BA 564 & BA 508)
- Successful completion of 75% of Foundation Courses is required before taking Vancouver Residency
- Successful completion of 75% of Program is required before taking Capstone Residency
- Successful completion of Residencies is required. Minimal passing grade is 60% (P)
- Students who fail BA 514 People, Organization, and Culture (5-credit Vancouver Residency) will all be required to withdraw from the IMBA program

To meet November 2025 graduation requirements, the last possible date to complete outstanding Courses/credits is **August 31, 2025**.

University regulations establish a **five-year time limit** for the completion of a master's program.
