The *Legatio Babylonica*, written in Latin in 1501 by humanist Peter Martyr d’Anghiera, is a *relazione* or description of the author’s diplomatic mission to Venice and Egypt that includes his personal views on Western and Islamic civilization. This presentation will provide an overview of Raúl Álvarez Moreno’s recent edition and translation of the book (June 2013), focusing on the relevance of the text and on some of the main contributions of the research project.
