How to see *all* the exercises...

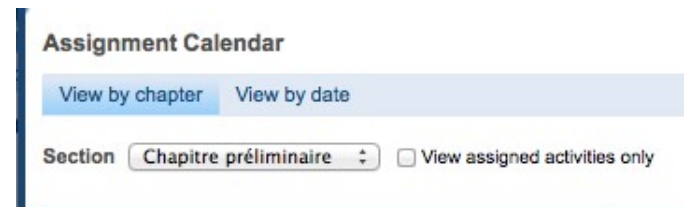
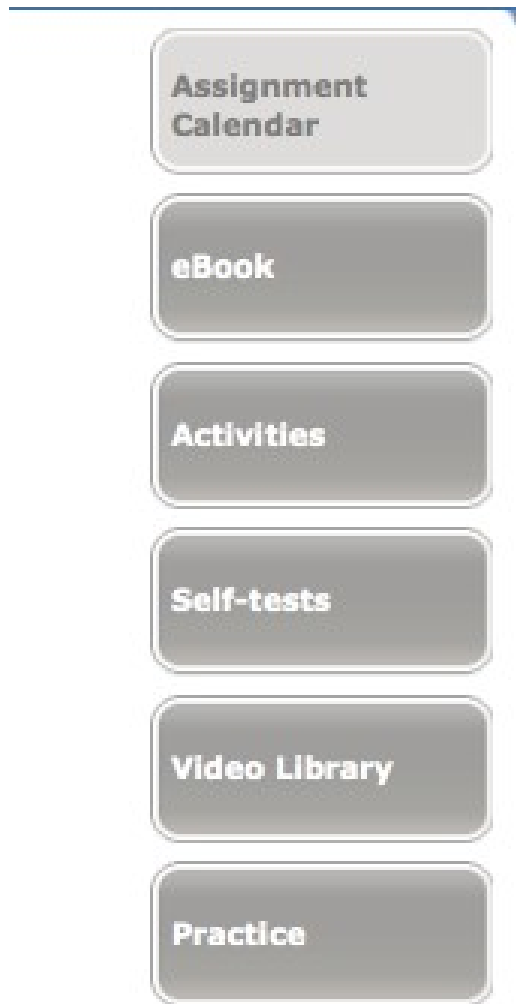
- ... including the Lab comprehension and pronunciation practice ones (but not Lab tests)
