Curriculum Programs



Curriculum Programs deliver multi-sensory workshops to students of all ages.

- Learning Labs and Classrooms | interactive wet labs, dissections and play based programs
- Vancouver Aquarium Experience | Guided tours through the aquarium connect students to global ecosystems and establish a sense of place in their communities.
- Coastal Ecosystems | These are outdoor, hands-on introduction to the skills and tools that marine scientists use on a daily basis.





Mobile Programs



Mobile Programs is the traveling education stream of Ocean Wise.

- Programs feature live animals, marine artifacts, and hands-on interactive activities
- Our educators deliver expert level, multi-sensory aquatic programs, based on the Ocean Literacy Framework.
- We bring ocean education to schools, youth groups, and communities coast to coast. To date we have engaged over 625,000 students, youth and community members.





Online Programs



Online Learning is an interactive environment that furthers understanding and connection to the ocean at education.ocean.org

- Multilingual Learning Platforms: resources, quizzes, videos and badges
- Social Learning: video conferencing and online portals provide a platform for global student conversations
- Virtual Visits: video conferences enable student-driven experiences with aquarium habitats

 Sleepovers & Birthdays: tour with experiences educator, multisensory exploration of BC intertidal zone

 Youth Leadership: immersive conservation and sustainability workshops, mentorship or next generation of ocean champions






Ocean Bridge (youth mentorship)



Ocean Bridge connects Canadian youth from coast to coast to coast empowering them to make a difference towards ocean conservation.

- Each year 40 youth (ages 18-30) form a national team engaged in co-creating and delivering service projects for their home communities
- Community & Capacity Building Through regular video conference sessions and an interactive online environment, youth connect as a national team and with the broader community of ocean conservation.
