CONTENT: **What** am I going to teach?

LEARNERS: **Who** am I going to teach?

STRATEGIES/METHODS: **How** am I going to teach this?

RATIONALE: **Why** am I going to teach this at this time, to this group of learners, in this way?

OPENING

ACTIVITIES

CLOSURE

EVALUATION/ASSESSMENT

MATERIALS/RESOURCES

TIMING

MODIFICATIONS (for learners with special needs)
