School Board Chairs Superintendents of Schools

Re: District Grant - (\$50/FTE Student)

I am pleased to announce that the Ministry of Education will be distributing a one-time grant of \$50 per school-aged FTE to each British Columbia school district. The funding for this grant arises from savings resulting from the recent labour disruption in the education sector.

A list of the grants, by school district, is attached. The grant is intended to assist school districts to meet their commitments to improve student achievement.

School districts should treat textbooks and learning resources as the first priority for this grant.

To receive the funds, each district must submit a Spending Plan to the Ministry of Education. The Spending Plan must:

- Demonstrate how the funds will contribute to improved student achievement in their district and describe the measures used to monitor improvement.
- Describe the type of expenditures, such as:
 - o textbooks and learning resources
 - o lab equipment
 - o computers
 - o school libraries
 - o special education assessments
 - o literacy programs
 - o drug awareness programs
 - o healthy schools
 - staff resources
- Guarantee that the funds will be expended by March 31, 2006. Funds not spent by March 31 revert to the Ministry of Education.
- Be developed in partnership with the broader parent community and staff.
- Be signed off by the superintendent of schools and the community's education partners.
- Be received by the Ministry of Education no later than January 10, 2006.
