For the twelfth year running, the Patient & Community Partnership for Education at UBC and Fraser Valley Aboriginal Child and Family Services Society (FVACFSS, Xyolhemeylth) in Chilliwack are offering learning opportunities this summer 2016 for health professional students to attend overnight camps organized by the community.

Placements are for one of the 3-day or 4-day youth and family summer camps or youth day camps which aim to teach children and youth about Aboriginal traditions and values.

At the camps, you will have the chance to interact with the community, including elders, and participate in cultural events. This is a rare opportunity to immerse yourself in the unique Stó:lō and other traditional cultures in

- Natural Changes (females only) July 19-22, 2016
  - Warrior (males only) July 19-22, 2016
  - Caregiver camp (foster care families) July 13-15, 2016
  - Family Camp August 10-12, 2016
  - Youth Day Camps (1 day camps / no overnight) July 7, 8 and 28, 2016
