Epicurean argument for atoms

- 1. Reality is made up only of matter & void
 - sense data shows us material things, & void must exist for matter to move or to be cut
 - matter and void exhaust possibilities for what exists (matter = stuff; void = emptiness)
- 2. Matter cannot come into existence from nothing
- 3. So some matter must be eternal: things that exist now must have come from other matter, which came from previous matter, etc.
- 4. Large material things do not exist eternally, so some small material things must exist eternally
- 6. You can't keep cutting material things forever: they would eventually disappear into pure void (and thus there would be no matter in them)

Therefore, there must be small parts of matter ("atoms") that are not further divisible & exist eternally
