

MBA Student Evaluation & Promotion Regulations

- 1. Core: Please refer to the Core Handbook for evaluation methods for the Core portion of your program.
- 2. Post Core: A minimum grade of 60% (P) must be achieved in all post-core courses taken for credit (including both required and elective courses). In compelling circumstances a course in which a grade of less than 60% (P) was obtained may be repeated for a higher standing or an alternate course may be taken on approval of the MBA Office.
- A student will be required to withdraw from the program under the following circumstances:

Core:

 Please refer to the Core Handbook for evaluation methods for the Core portion of your program.

Post-Core:

- More than 3 credits* with grades below 60% or,
- 3 credits with grades below 60% and more than 4.5 credits with grades in the 60-67% range or,
- 1.5 credits with grades below 60% and more than 6 credits with grades in the 60-67% range or,
- More than 9 credits with grades in the 60-67% range.

Students who do not write the final exam or complete course requirements will receive "did not write" (DNW) or "incomplete" on their transcript. This will normally be considered as a fail.

Students who achieve a course grade below 68% can expect to receive a letter from the Grades Review Committee cautioning that they are at academic risk and outlining requirements to continue in the program.
