Randy Sung Education Award

The Minerva Foundation for BC Women is building a sustainable community of women leaders. The Minerva Foundation Education Awards promote the development of women leaders through education, by assisting them with the costs of tuition. Our education awards target women who will have the most impact in their work or community, and those in fields or demographic groups who are currently underrepresented in leadership roles.

This fund for BC women seeking to pursue their career in Business is a result of the generosity of the **Randy Sung Education Endowment Fund**. The Minerva Foundation Award will be made available to a female resident of BC with demonstrated financial need, academic proficiency and community engagement. Candidates must have a minimum of 2.00. Candidates may be graduates or undergraduate students and must be registered in an approved full-time business program at the UBC Sauder School of Business. Challenge, audit and credit free courses will not be considered.

Candidates must meet at least one of the Foundation's criteria:

1. Assist single mothers in advancing their education.
2. Retrain mature women returning to the workforce.
3. Advance women in a non-traditional field of study.
4. Assist immigrant women, Aboriginal women or women with disabilities to overcome educational barriers.
