FOR PROSPECTIVE COMPETITORS:

What is NSCC? NSCC is an invaluable opportunity for 12 undergraduate and 8 MBA teams from across Canada to compete on a national stage for a chance to be recognized by the top consulting firms in the country. The aim of NSCC is to provide competitors with an authentic consulting engagement simulation. The structure of the competition is the following:

- September 10 – October 1, 2014: Preliminary case period
- November 6, 2014: Day 1 (Welcome Dinner)
- November 7, 2014: Day 2 (Round 2 begins; Evening networking event)
- November 8, 2014: Day 3 (Round 2 ends/judging, Round 3 during Gala Dinner)

When is the competition? Important dates and deadlines include:

- September 10, 2014: Registration opens; preliminary cases released
- October 1, 2014 11:59 PM: Preliminary case submissions due
- October 8, 2014: Teams notified whether advancing or not
- November 6-8, 2014: NSCC Event

What is the prize? Winning teams in each category (undergraduate or MBA/masters) will receive a cash prize of \$1,500 and first round interviews with Deloitte Consulting's Strategy & Operations group. Winners of each category may also be offered additional interviews by participating consulting firms based on the final round performance.

How much does it cost to enter? It costs \$40 to enter the preliminary round and if chosen, \$180/\$250 depending on the number of nights stayed at the Hyatt Regency hotel (choice of 2 or 3 nights).

- What is NSCC?** NSCC offers delegates the opportunity to gain a well-rounded understanding of the consulting industry and network with professional from top consulting firms during our Wine & Cheese reception.
