The President shall:

- g. Chair Executive Council meetings.

- i. Work with VP Internal to draft budgets for activities and items purchased.
- j. Work with VP Events/VP Careers to attend networking events during school periods.
- k. Supervise and direct the duties of Executive Council members.
- I. Promote the Sauder School of Business reputation and establish a positive image in the external business community.
- m. Create a summary of the MBAN year for reference for next year's Executive Council.
- n. Be the Graduate Student Society (GSS) Representative for MBAN.
