## Alternative Options for Advanced Modules

### PT MBA Class of 2019

### FT MBA Class of 2020

- Classes are held 1-2X (4 hours total) a week for 5 weeks (mostly daytime)
- Exams in week 6 (cannot be rescheduled)

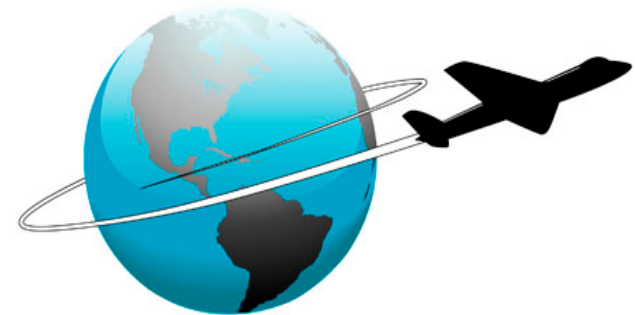
