Application Information for Spring & Summer Programs

Most of the above programs are offered by official exchange partners of the Robert H. Lee Graduate School, Sauder School of Business. UBC IMBA students, if selected to participate by the RHL Graduate School, do not pay tuition for these programs. Other expenses are the responsibility of the attending student.

Exchange Partner programs require a 2-step application process. Firstly, UBC IMBA students need to apply to the RHL Graduate School, using Go Global Application portal. Go Global has an <u>application fee of \$415.00</u> for all exchange applications. This fee will be charged to your SSC account. We will review your application, and if approved, nominate you to the selected school. You will then be required to complete paperwork and course selection directly with the school.
