Midterm 1 reflection forms

- Reading the class notes and reviewing webwork problems are the most essential part of exam preparation.
- Student who scored 90% or above in their exam spent approximately 30% of their time on class notes and 20% on reviewing webwork problems.




Figure 1: Why students lost mark?

- It is absolutely essential to start your webwork problems as early as possible.
- Students who scored 90% or higher in their exam start their webwork problems on day 5 or earlier. On the other hand, student who scored 70% or less, started their webwork on day 8 or later.
- As for changing your study habits, three main themes were common: 1) Come to office hour, 2) Practice more. 3) Be more careful on the exam.

- <u>Old exams</u> are a valuable resource for exam preparation. Remember that some of the old exams do have a solution key. Check searchable database.
- Two or three sets of extra problems are posted every week. If you need more, check out <u>CLP problem booklet</u>.
