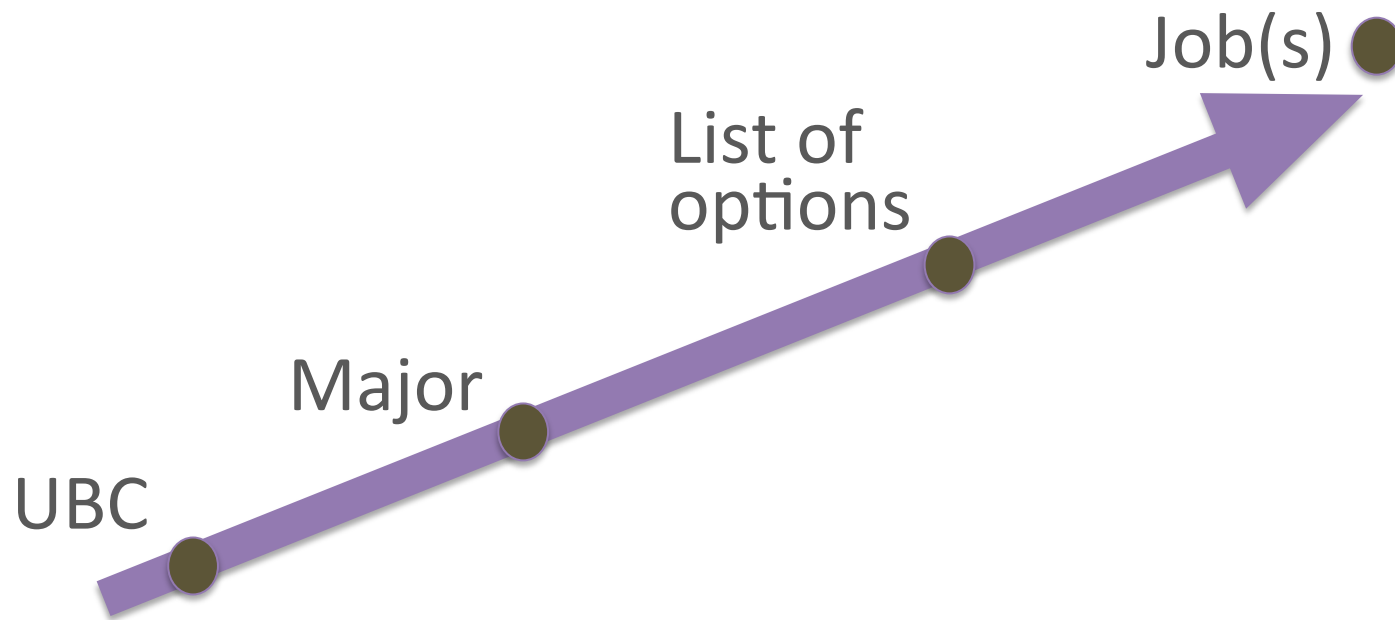

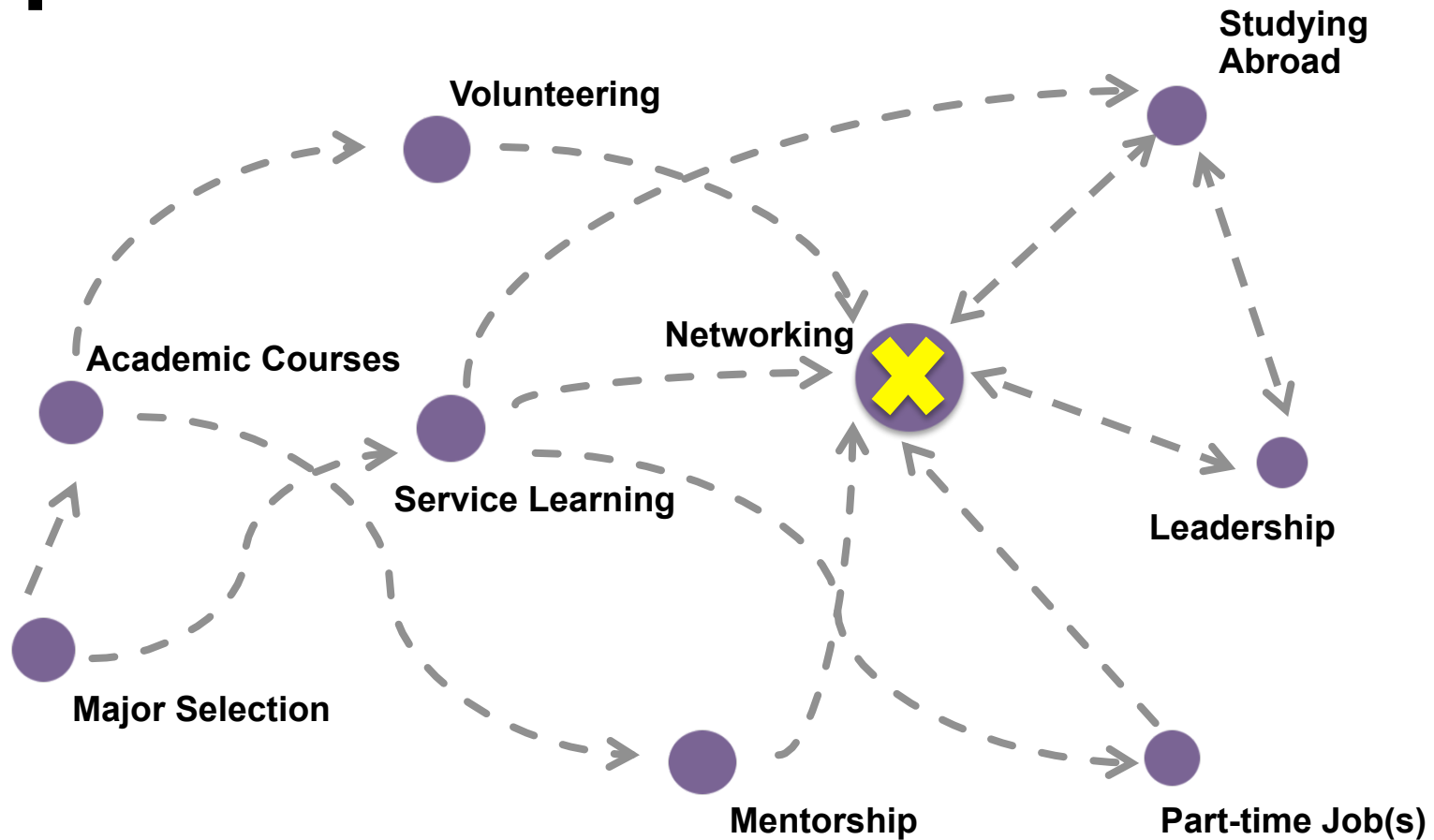
The expected trajectory

The people you meet, the places you go, and all the different things you try, all add value to your learning and the opportunities available at UBC.

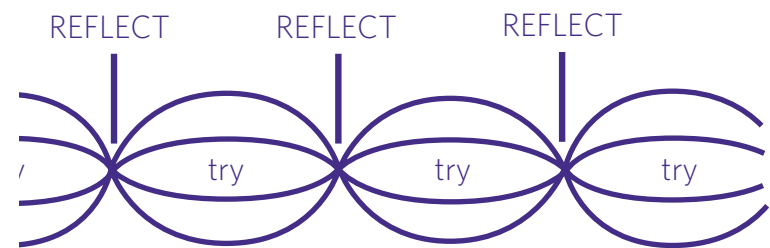

Be a student in a different part of the world to **get perspective from a different place**. Navigating unfamiliar places and new situations builds confidence and challenges you to adapt.

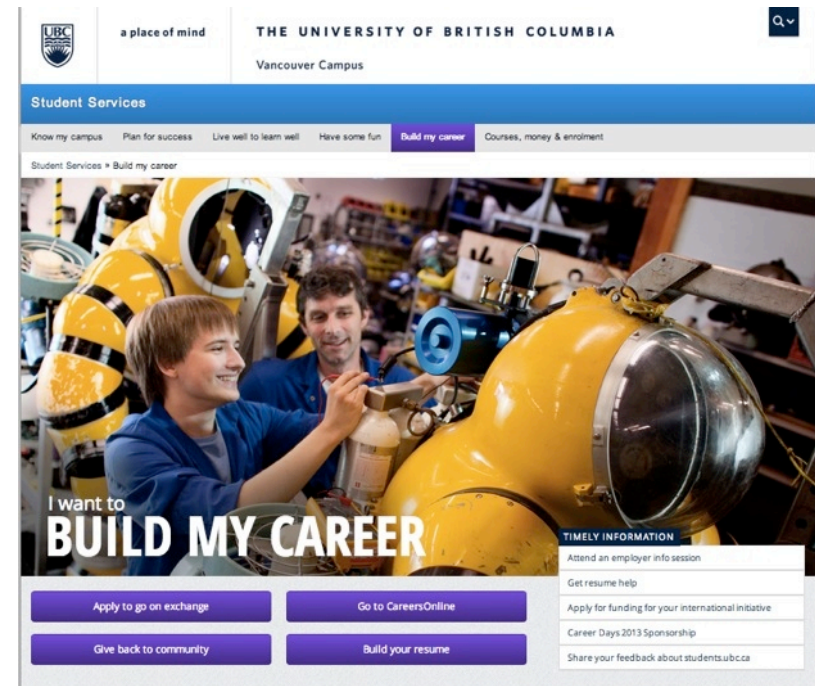
