The project

Are you excited to advance the nursing profession? Want an opportunity to apply your new nursing skills and support your ongoing development as a nursing professional? **The Nursing Community Assessment Service (NCAS) is looking for nursing students or recent grads** to review and test the content of a bilingual, multi-profession nursing exam.

The opportunity

You can sign up for either or both of the following phases:

Pilot test (May 2023): As a **pilot-tester**, you will be part of a virtual focus group. You will review and share feedback on the content of a nursing assessment alongside other subject matter experts.

Field test (June 2023): As a **field-tester**, you will get to practice and apply your nursing skills by answering a 2 to 3-hour computer-based exam testing entry-level RN and/or LPN competencies.

Details

To participate you must:

- be completing your last practicum in an LPN or RN program; or
- have recently graduated from an LPN or RN program

This activity will be paid. Bilingualism (English and French) is an asset but is not required.
