

designs on butterfly wings:

- salmon: "life-giver"
musqueam people have historical, cultural and spiritual ties to the salmon - strong part of their identity. Musqueam logo depicts a salmon
- eagles:

- raven: creation, knowledge, prestige, complexity of nature

Cross: Christian cross
 → in away degrades indigenous ways of living
 → notion that the church is able to do what they want, can get away with it because "it's what god wants"

Helia: cedar
 - carved

overlapping butterfly wings in a circular format
 → like that of a spindle wheel representing the circle of life

spindle wheel:
 also represents the close connection of her people to this land
 → church purity
 excuse to commit horrendous crimes

White:
 - purity
 → what they were?
 → what the church wanted them to become

blue

white dominance
 → white people dominating, suppressing indigenous peoples
 & settler colonialism

Reminder:
 all things are connected
 everything we do makes an impression
 we may not be able to see

they are all connected:
 what happens to one will happen to the next
 → it will affect all the others

4 butterfly wings:
 - number 4 has a great significance
 - 4 seasons
 - 4 winds
 - 4 directions

→ salmon lives are measured in 4 parts
 eggs hatch → travel to ocean, live there
 → by eggs died → long, dangerous journey back
