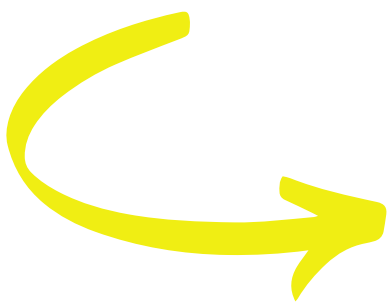


WHAT IS A HATE CRIME?

Some basics, according to the FBI **Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program's Hate Crime Statistics**:

THE FBI'S DEFINITION:



"A **committed criminal offense** which is motivated, in whole or in part, by the offender's **bias(es)** against a **race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, ethnicity, gender, or gender identity**"

- Types of **victims**
- Number of **offenders**
- Type of **location**
- **Jurisdiction**

DATA THE FBI COLLECTS



TYPES OF VICTIMS:

- An **individual**
- A **business**
- An **institution**
- **Society** as a whole

TYPES OF OFFENDERS:

- **Known** = some aspect of the suspect was identified
- **Unknown** = the suspect was not identified

HOW IT'S REPORTED:

Participation in the FBI UCR Program is **mandated for federal law enforcement agencies (LEA)** but **voluntary** for local, state, and tribal level LEA's.
