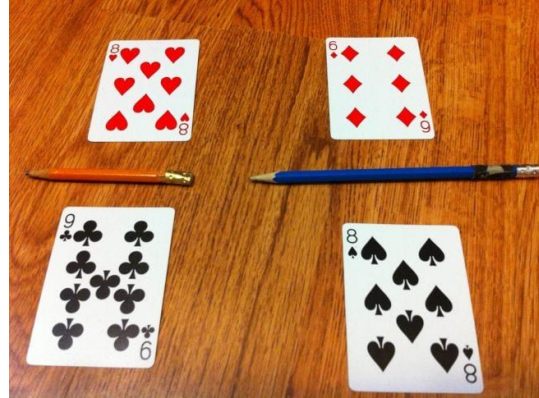

Non-Tech Numeracy Activities



What shapes do you see in the picture? Draw the shapes and divide them into parts with equal parts. Explain how you know the parts have equal areas.



Players deal two cards, a numerator and denominator, then determine whose fraction is the largest. The winner keeps all four cards, and play continues until the cards are gone.

Fractions In A Cup

Place several small objects in a cup (or container). Shake gently and pour the contents out. What fractions do you see? Reroll to create other fractions.

Divide a large pile of objects (cereal, stuffed animals, blocks, etc.) equally into piles. What fraction is represented? Recombine the group to divide into other fractions. How many can you find?
