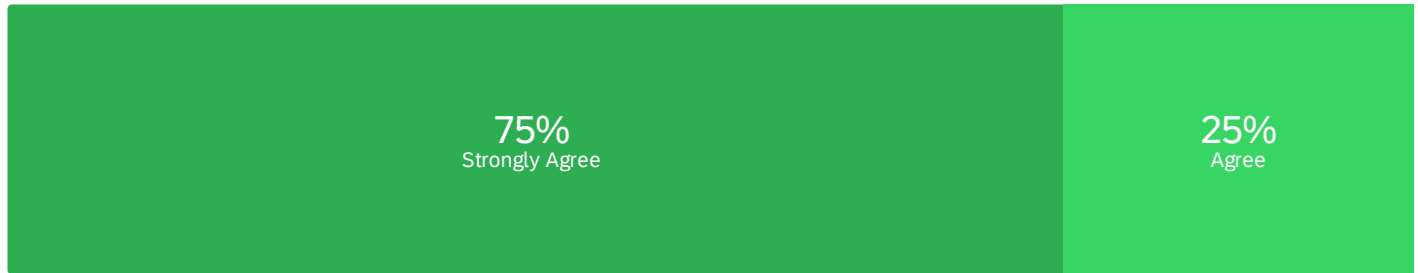

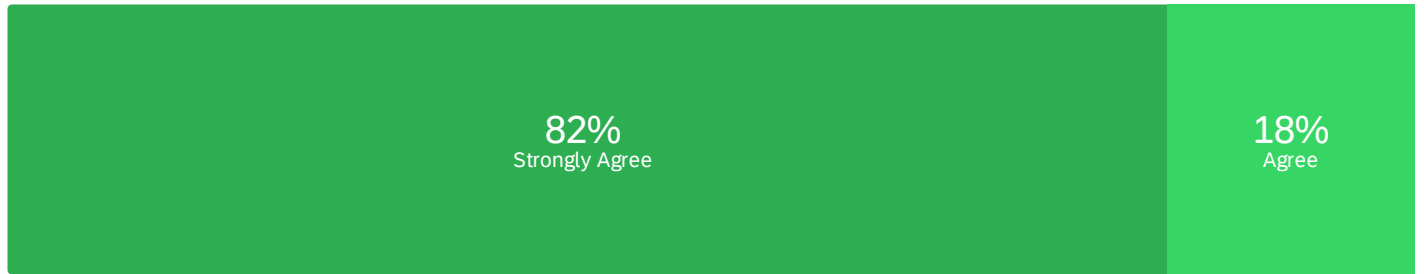

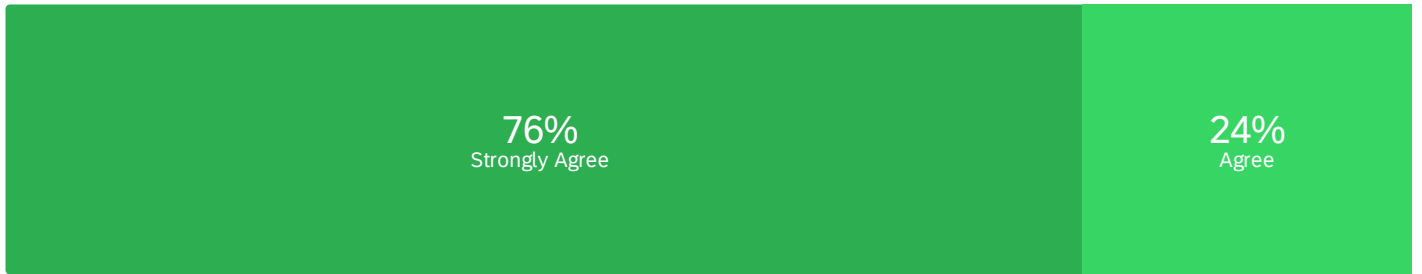

The TA helped create a positive classroom or laboratory atmosphere that promoted learning.

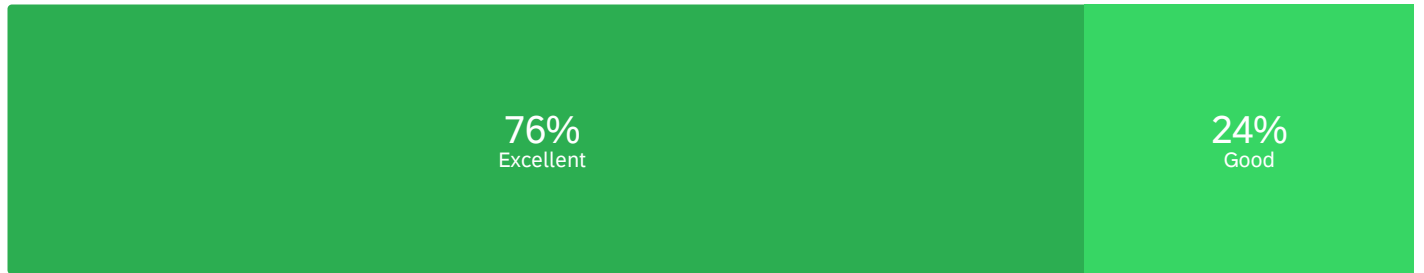

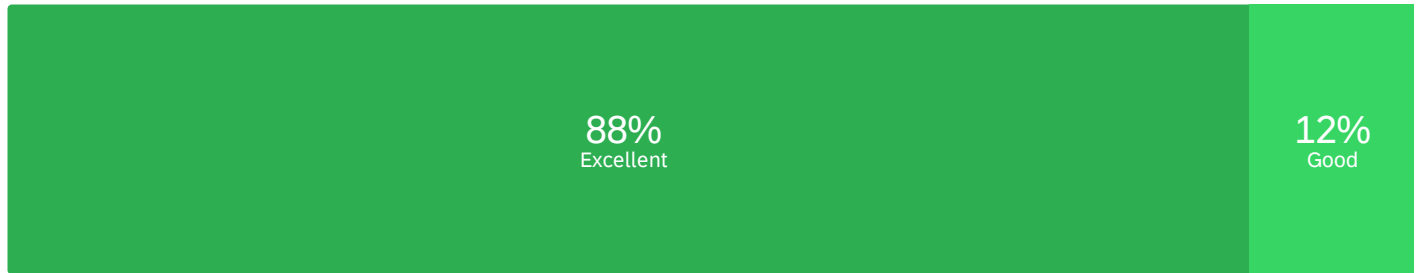

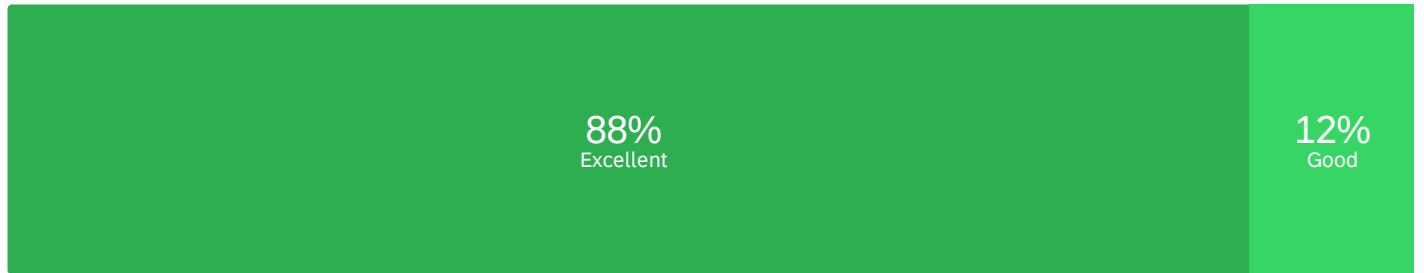
