

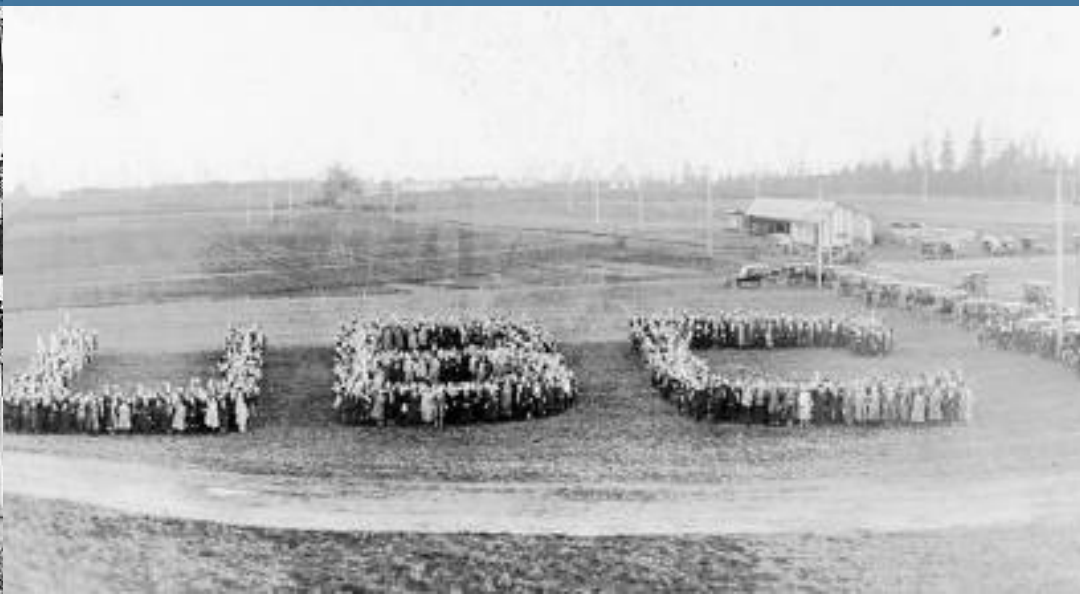
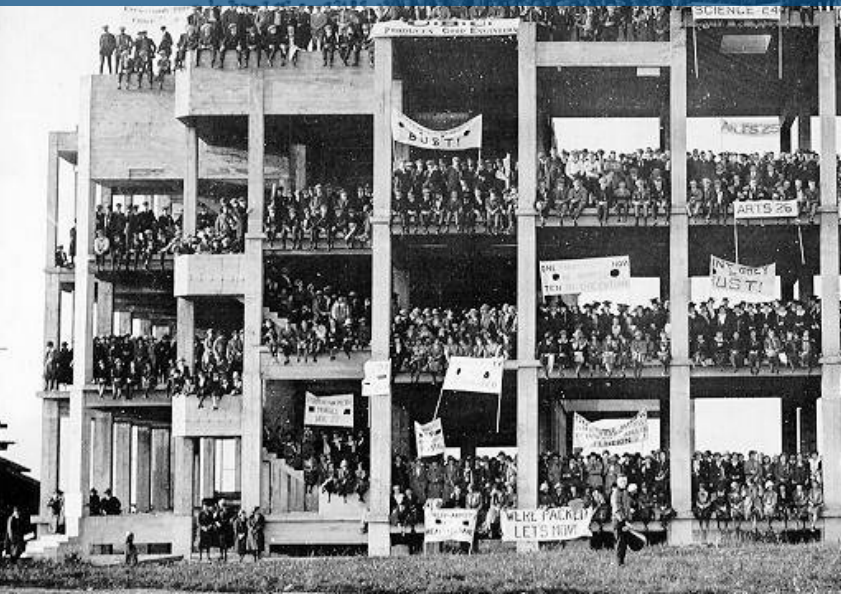

A BRIEF HISTORY OF UBC

- **1908** Government legislation passed to create a university for British Columbia
- **1915** UBC opens its doors
- **1919** First graduate degrees granted
- **1925** UBC moves to Vancouver's Point Grey neighbourhood
- **1959** International House opened by Eleanor Roosevelt
- **1972** TRIUMF opens (still the world's largest cyclotron)
- **1993** Professor Michael Smith wins 1993 Nobel Prize in Chemistry
- **2001** UBC opens its Robson Square site
- **2005** UBC Okanagan Campus opens
- **2010** UBC becomes a host venue for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games
- **2015** UBC celebrates its Centennial
