







A BRIEF HISTORY OF UBC

- 1908 Government legislation passed to create a university for British Columbia
- 1915 UBC opens its doors
- 1919 First graduate degrees granted
- 1925 UBC moves to Vancouver's Point Grey neighbourhood
- 1959 International House opened by Eleanor Roosevelt
- 1972 TRIUMF opens (still the world's largest cyclotron)
- 1993 Professor Michael Smith wins 1993 Nobel Prize in Chemistry
- 2001 UBC opens its Robson Square site
- 2005 UBC Okanagan Campus opens
- 2010 UBC becomes a host venue for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games
- 2015 UBC celebrates its Centennial
