The Department of Education Leadership offers both a k-12 and higher education Ed.D and a Master of Arts degree in Education Leadership.

Additionally, it is anticipated that one of the successful candidates for the vacant positions will possess the background, skills and interest to serve as chair of the department as part of his/her faculty load.

Required Qualifications

- An earned doctorate in Education.
- Contemporary knowledge and experience in the field of education.
- Experience leading dissertation projects.
- Ability to actively engage students in learning.
- Evidence of ability to conduct research leading to publication.
- Demonstrated commitment to diversity.
- Excellent oral, written and interpersonal communication skills.
- Schedule flexibility to assume teaching responsibilities for Friday night and Saturday classes ongoing throughout the academic year

Desired Qualifications

- Knowledge of and experience with local, state and national educational issues and trends across the p-22 pipeline (preschool- higher education).
- Expertise in qualitative and or quantitative research methodology.
- Experience in the effective use of technology in educational practice.
- Successful involvement with university-public school partnerships.
- Pedagogical experience with hybrid or online teaching strategies

Responsibilities

- Carry a 12-unit course load per semester caseload based upon teaching, leadership and dissertation assignments
- Serve as Chair of the Education Leadership department (one of the successful candidates)
- Develop an active record of scholarship.
- Serve as a member of the Dean's cabinet (chair)
- Engage in scholarly activities leading to grants, presentations and/or publications.
- Participate in service to the Department, School, University and p-22 education community.

The Graduate School of Education at California Lutheran University invites applications from outstanding educators for two full time tenure track faculty position at the Assistant or Associate professor Level to commence in summer 2014. Common responsibilities for both positions include teaching in the MA and doctoral programs/credential courses, student advisement, and service to the university and broader community. Additionally, it is anticipated that at the conclusion of the selection process key departmental needs will be addressed per the following:

- One(or both) of the successful candidates will have the experience and expertise to teach and advise dissertation work for students in the K-12 strand of the doctoral program
- One (or both) of the successful candidates will have the experience and expertise to teach and advise in the higher education strand of the doctoral program.
- One of the successful candidates will have the background, experience and interest to teach coursework in quantitative methods and to provide dissertation advisement in this area
- One of the successful candidates will have the experience, background and interest to serve as chair of the department as part of his/her faculty load

Qualifications include an earned doctorate in Educational Leadership or related field, experience working in P-12 and/or higher educational settings. Additionally, experience in doctoral dissertation advisement is preferred.
