We will have room for poster displays if that is your preferred format, or if you are unable to attend Research Day in person.

A full proposal consists of:

- 250–500 word proposal or abstract
- AV requirements
- Presenters' names, department, and programme of study
- For panel formats only: brief summary of activities planned for the 75-minute time slot
