

## **Masters Presentation Format**

Recommended Presentation Sequence: (20-30 minutes Total)



In general, the sequence of the presentation should mirror the organization of the research. Do not try to cover everything. Less is more. Use examples of your data rather than attempting to cover everything. Do not read from a script— it's ok to read parts, but do not attempt to read through the entire presentation. The goal is to communicate with a fluent style to a general audience. This is a chance for the audience to judge your presentation capabilities. Be sure to arrive early to prepare the technology that will be used. The only way to deliver an adequate or outstanding presentation is to practice. Practice, Practice, Practice.
