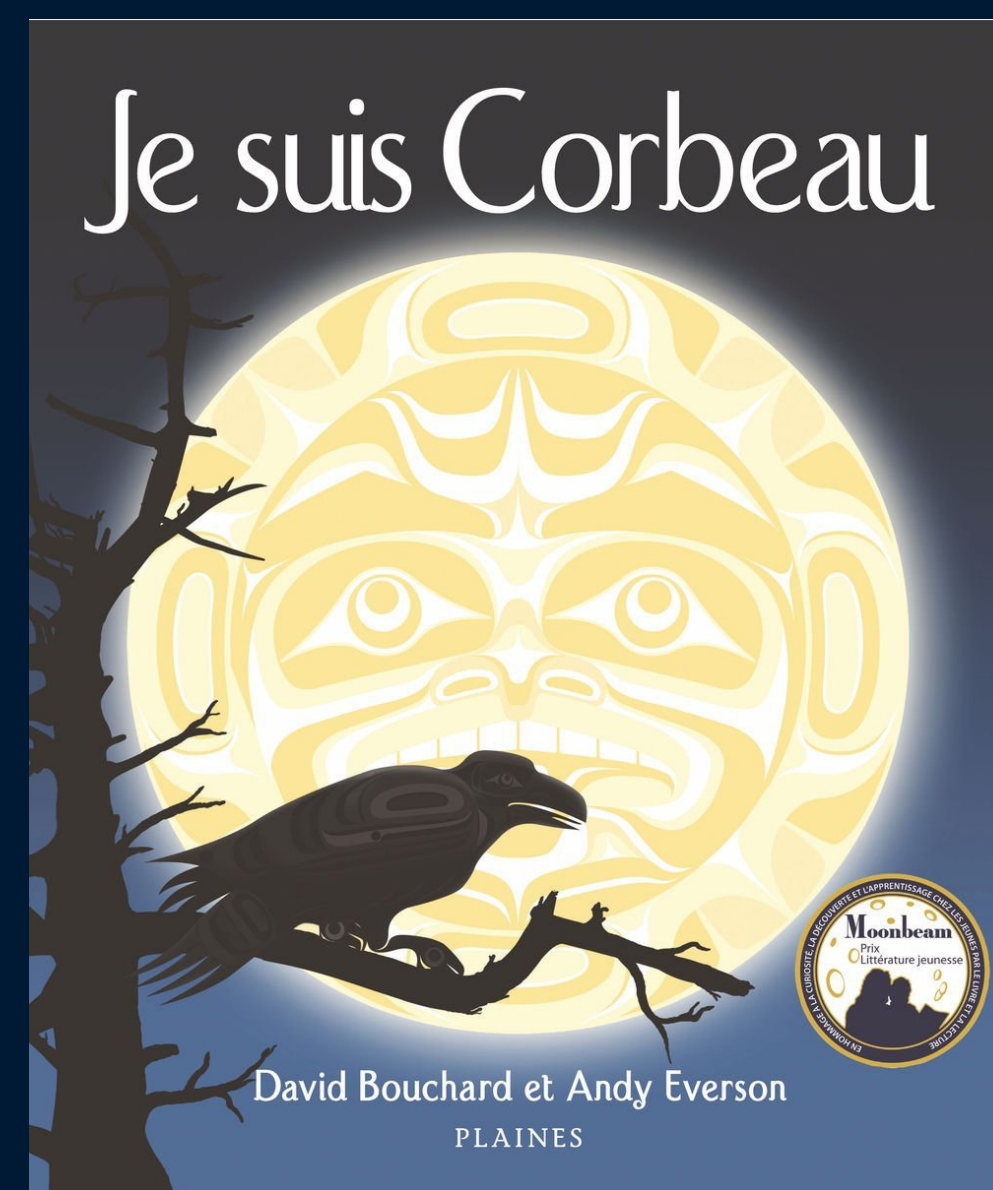

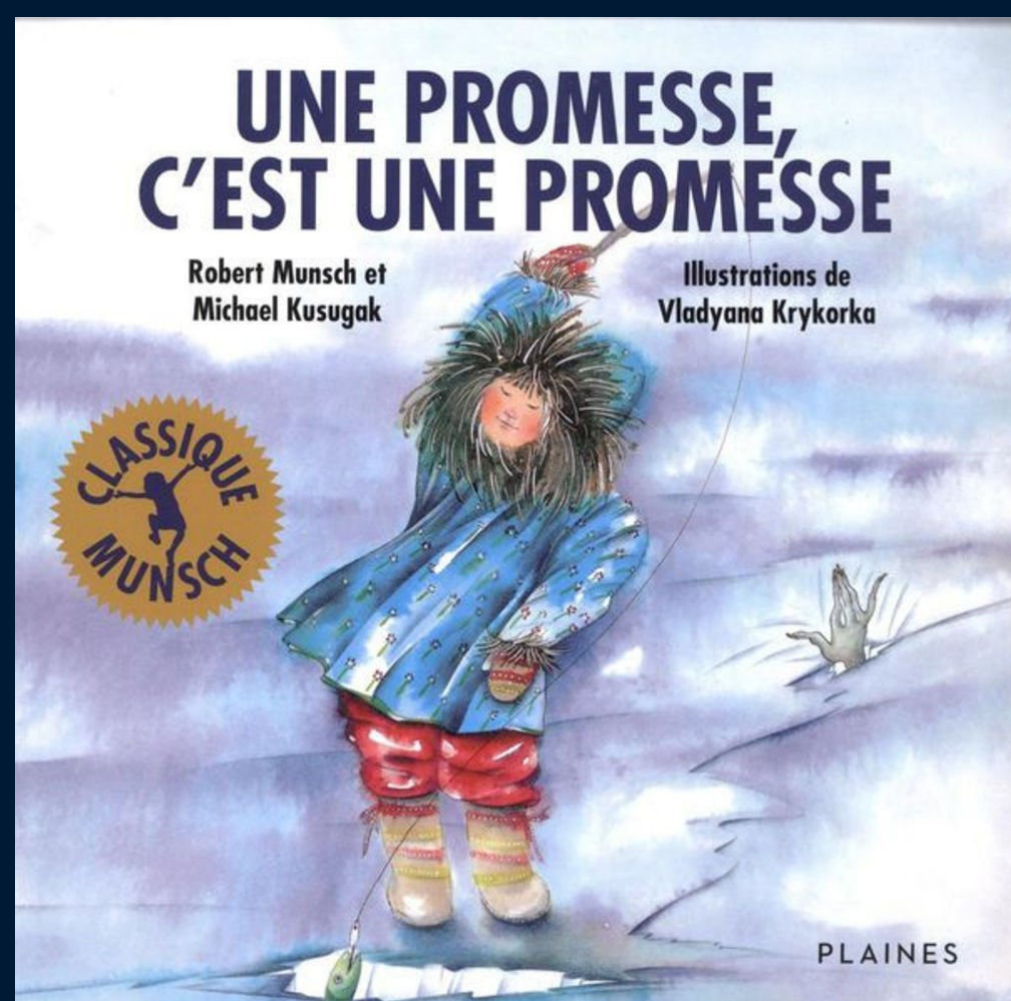

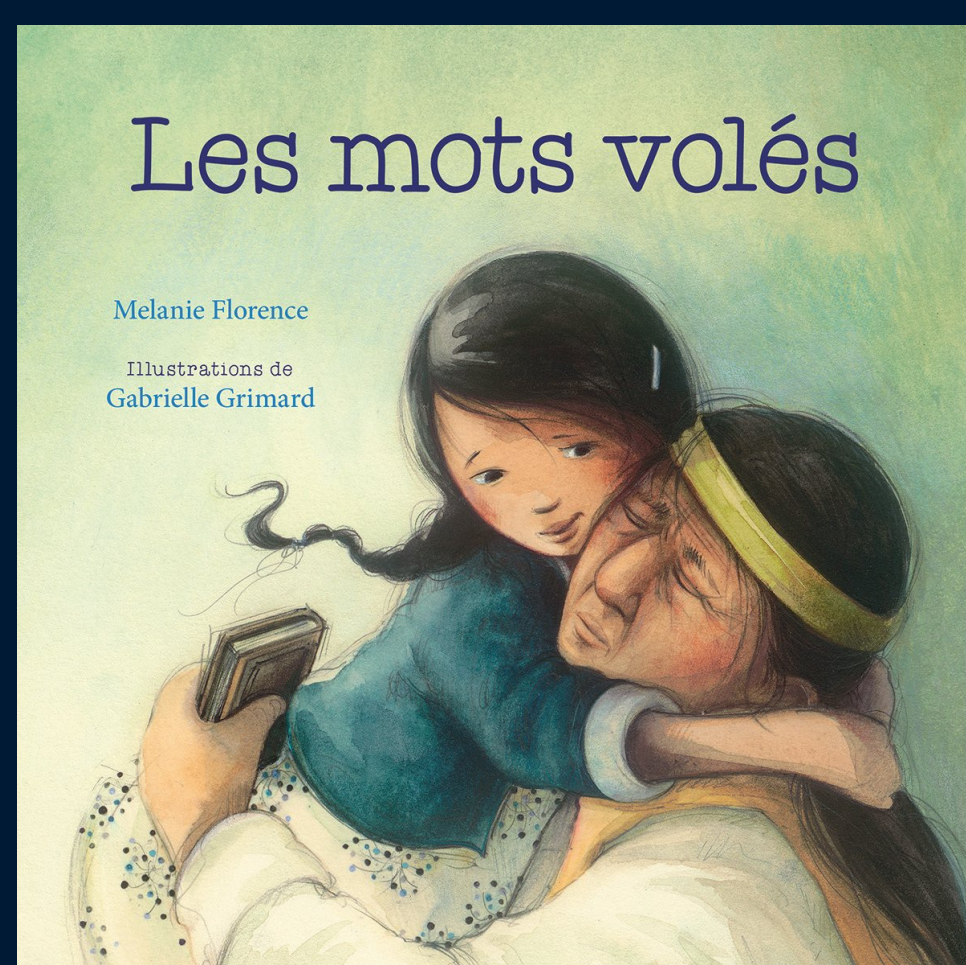

- Consult Xwi7wxa Library's Indigenous Children's Literature guide
- Search using the General tab on the UBC Library website to look for material in all UBC Library branches.
- Search using "Search Education Resources" box in the left hand bar on the Education Library website to limit your results to physical materials in the Education Library.
- Use specific search terms to narrow your results, such as: "pensionnat indien," "First Nations," Indigenous, Aboriginal, "Indians of North America," Musqueam (or any nation).

To find lesson plans, include "lesson plans", "lesson planning", or "activity programs" in your search terms.
