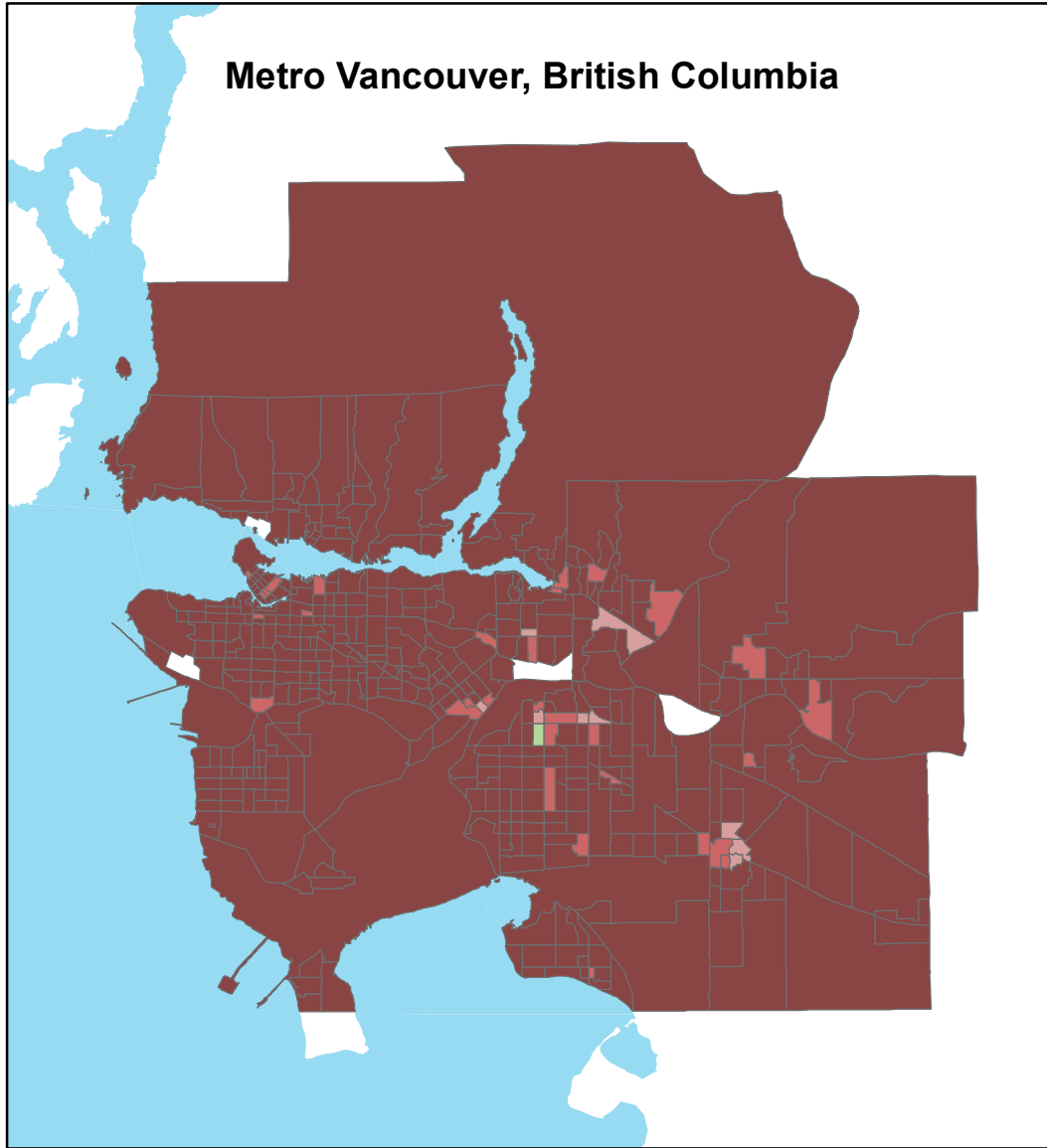


Housing Affordability in Metro Vancouver and London

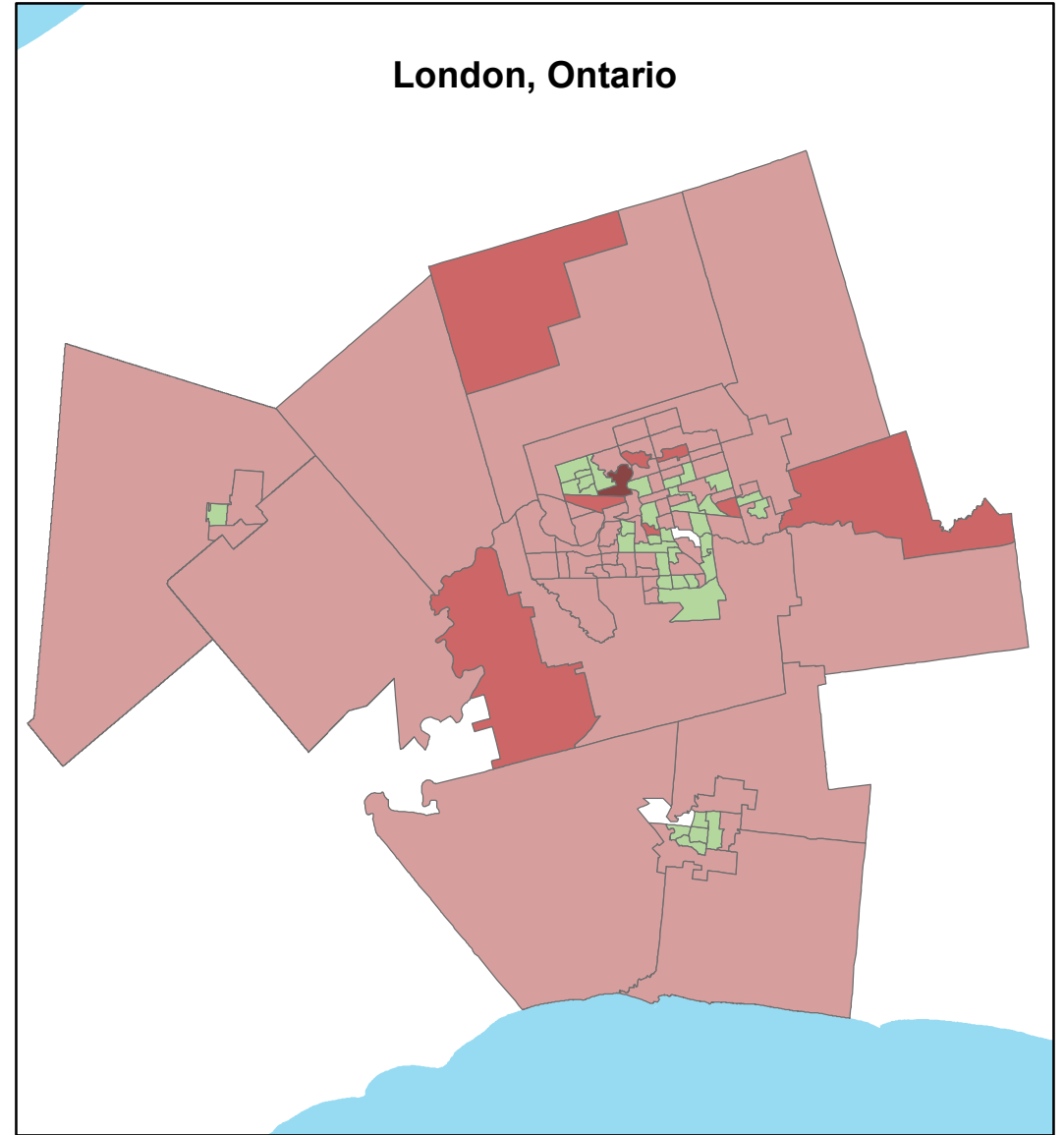

Housing Affordability based on Demographia's Classes of Median Multiple

- Affordable
- Moderately Unaffordable
- Seriously Unaffordable
- Severely Unaffordable

Median Multiple is a measure of housing affordability corresponding to median house price divided by median household income. A value of 3.0 and under is considered "Affordable", 3.1- 4.0 is "Moderately Unaffordable", 4.1-5.0 is "Seriously Unaffordable", and greater than 5.0 is "Severely Unaffordable".
