<b>First Impressions</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write a paragraph that generalizes your first impression upon reading the document.</li> <li>Begin with the positive and also provide a general critical comment (unless the document is outstanding and you can find no room for improvements).</li> <li>Is the URL customized?</li> </ul>
<b>Introduction</b>	<b>Profile Photo and Background Photo</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is there a Profile Photo and a Background Photo?</li> <li>Comment on the photo's quality (resolution, size, focal point)</li> <li>Is the photo professional (facial expression, clothing, relevance to field of work)?</li> <li>Does the photo speak for the author's personality and expertise?</li> <li>Does the Background photo overpower/contrast the Profile photo?</li> </ul>
	<b>Headline and Summary</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is there a Headline and a Summary?</li> <li>Comment on the Headline: Is it memorable? Does it contain relevant keywords?</li> <li>Comment on the Summary: Is it memorable? Is the length appropriate? Is there enough spacing in between? Does it show the author's personality? Does it add context to the author's career path? Does it contain relevant keywords?</li> </ul>

<b>Required Sections</b>	<b>Work and/or Volunteer Experience</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does the work/volunteer experience section highlight the author’s career path and personality?</li> <li>• Is there concise description with relevant keywords for each experience? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Are they listed in bullet points?</li> <li>○ Is there enough spacing in between paragraphs?</li> <li>○ Are the points structured effectively?</li> <li>○ Are quantifiable evidence (e.g. %, \$, numbers) included when appropriate?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<b>Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is the highest qualification listed?</li> <li>• Is there any further description (e.g. high GPA (above 80%), awards and scholarships (no description; describe in appropriate section), varsity experience, etc.)?</li> </ul>
	<b>Skills</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is there a sufficient amount of skills listed in all subsections (e.g. Industry Knowledge, Tools &amp; Technologies, Interpersonal Skills, etc.)?</li> <li>• Do the skills match and reflect the work/volunteer experience listed above?</li> <li>• Are the top (most in-demand) skills highlighted and moved to the top of the skill section?</li> </ul>
<b>Optional Sections (but highly recommended)</b>	<b>Licenses &amp; Certifications Endorsements &amp; Recommendations Accomplishment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are these sections included?</li> <li>• Are supported evidence (description, pictures, link to scholarship definition, etc.) included?</li> <li>• Are these relevant to the author’s career goals?</li> <li>• Are relevant courses to the author’s education listed?</li> </ul>
<b>Grammar and Expression</b>	<b>Grammar</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Comment on overall grammatical errors and suggest changes.</li> <li>• Is there a consistency in tone and language?</li> <li>• Are the points succinct and descriptive?</li> </ul>
	<b>Overall lay-out and design</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are visual effects used appropriately?</li> </ul>
<b>Other suggestions</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be specific and use bullet points to organize your suggested corrections.</li> </ul>
<b>Conclusion</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Summarizes your review and includes a bullet list of suggested edits.</li> </ul>
