Recent News from the Projects

- Land & Food Systems: expanding e-portfolios into all core courses; students will be introduced to e-portfolios in 1<sup>st</sup> year and will continue through 4-year program.
- **TAG**: all users migrated to iWebfolio 3.0.
- **Science**: Bryo-portfolio course will repeat e-portfolio use in Jan 2006; may also add Plant Resources course to pilot; presenting at ISSoTL Conference on Oct. 16.
- **English**: 2 distance writing course launched in Sept 2005 via WebCT.
- Pathology: 4<sup>th</sup> year course launched Sept 2005 via WebCT; focus on case-based learning online.
- Pharmacy: transition year; moving e-portfolio to student experiential rotations.
- **Education**: 1-year & 2-year cohorts engaged in e-portfolios; grad course will investigate digital storytelling.
- International Peer Program: approx. 400 students; central question: Do students learn from their experiences?
- Access Studies: investigating Elgg as an e-portfolio tool.
- Professional Staff: 7-10 staff members using blogfolios; focus group planned for late Oct.
