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UBC is at a critical juncture in the evolution of its pedgogical model and its ability to support students, faculty and staff in the competitive global higher education arena. We need to adapt our practices and processes and invest in underlying technologies to support this transformation.

The Student Information System (SIS) is a crucial system supporting our students' success as well as the foundation for many of our faculty and staff processes.

Our current SIS has reached its capacity to support our anticipated future needs. Therefore, we are undertaking an initiative to plan for the replacement of the SIS with a commercial product.

#### THE BIG PICTURE

A strategic decision has been made by UBC to replace our AGING, CUSTOM BUILT SIS with a VENDOR-SUPPLIED SYSTEM.

The SIS Governance Committee has ENDORSED the recommendation for SITS:VISION BY TRIBAL EDUCATION to replace the remaining SIS applications.

> SITS: Vision by Tribal Education is recommended to replace the remaining SIS applications

Custom built software as a result of case-by-case use scenarios


Purpose built – current functionality demands require workarounds


Stability and integrity of overall system is impacted by adding new functionality


