A Joint Message From  
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UBC is at a critical juncture in the evolution of its pedagogical model and its ability to support students, faculty and staff in the competitive global higher education arena. We need to adapt our practices and processes and invest in underlying technologies to support this transformation.

The Student Information System (SIS) is a crucial system supporting our students' success as well as the foundation for many of our faculty and staff processes.

Our current SIS has reached its capacity to support our anticipated future needs. Therefore, we are undertaking an initiative to plan for the replacement of the SIS with a commercial product.



## THE BIG PICTURE

A strategic decision has been made by UBC to replace our **AGING, CUSTOM BUILT** SIS with a **VENDOR-SUPPLIED SYSTEM**.

The SIS Governance Committee has **ENDORSED** the recommendation for **SITS:VISION BY TRIBAL EDUCATION** to replace the remaining SIS applications.

**TOGETHER** we will replace the **SIS** in the next ...



## WHY REPLACE THE SIS?

CURRENT	VS	FUTURE
Custom built software as a result of case-by-case use scenarios		Deployment of commercial software requires shorter timeframes than custom development
Purpose built – current functionality demands require workarounds		Configurable – unique UBC requirements quickly adapt to changing business needs
Stability and integrity of overall system is impacted by adding new functionality		Stable foundation allows for new and complex functionality
Students, faculty and staff are forced to use several applications throughout their experience to complete different tasks		Ultimately a tailored experience for students and faculty/staff
Reduced cost effectiveness, efficiency and adaptability to the evolving needs of the University		Reduced total cost of ownership

## THE RECOMMENDATION

*SITS:Vision* by Tribal Education is recommended to replace the remaining SIS applications

Based on previous project evaluations, market research and on-going assessments

## A MAJOR DECISION

The replacement of the SIS is a major decision requiring Executive approval

This action requires additional due diligence, market analysis and consultations

- 4 UBC applications independently chose *SITS:Vision* by Tribal Education as a solution

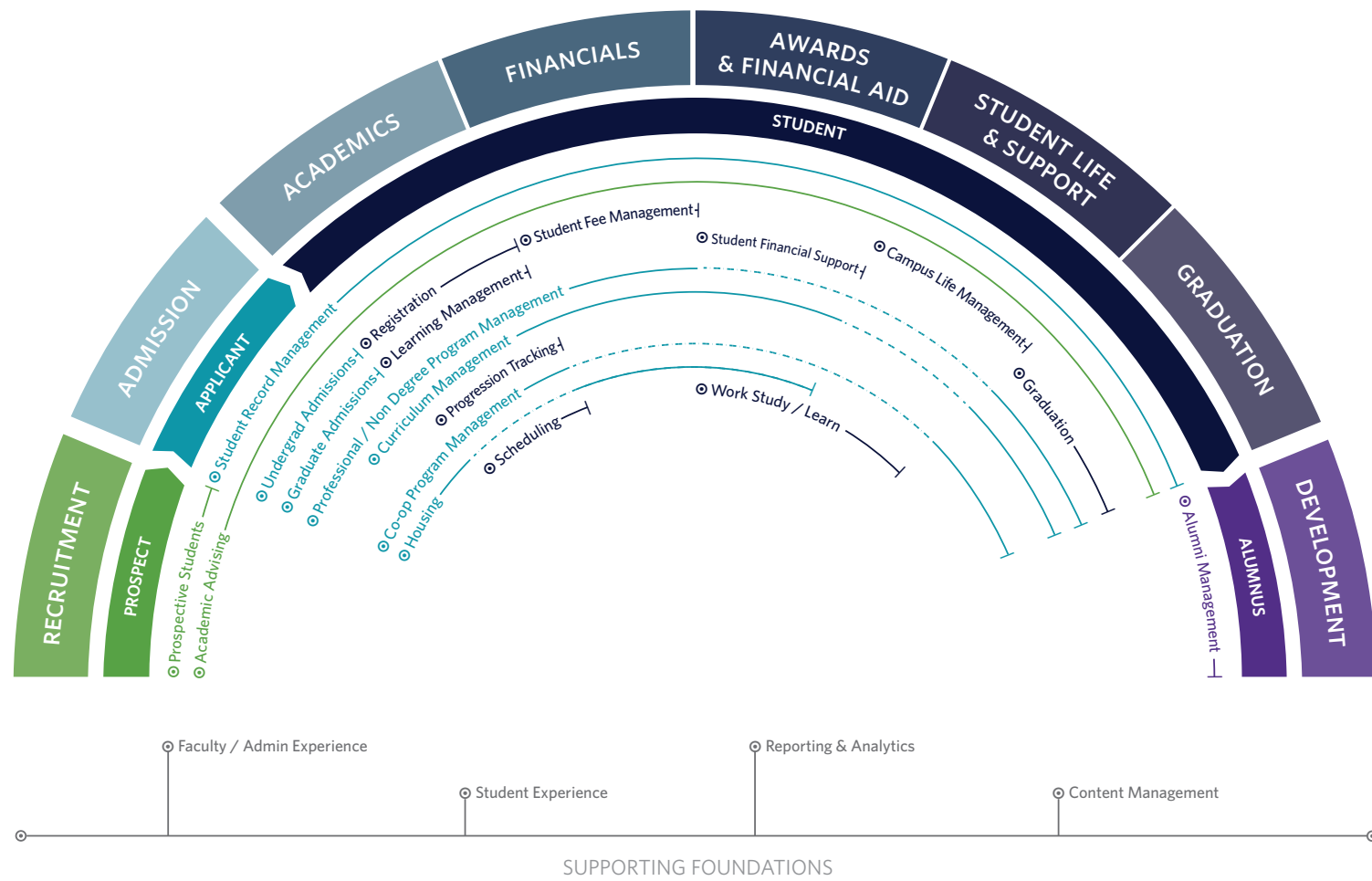
### University-wide workshops

### Further due diligence and market analysis

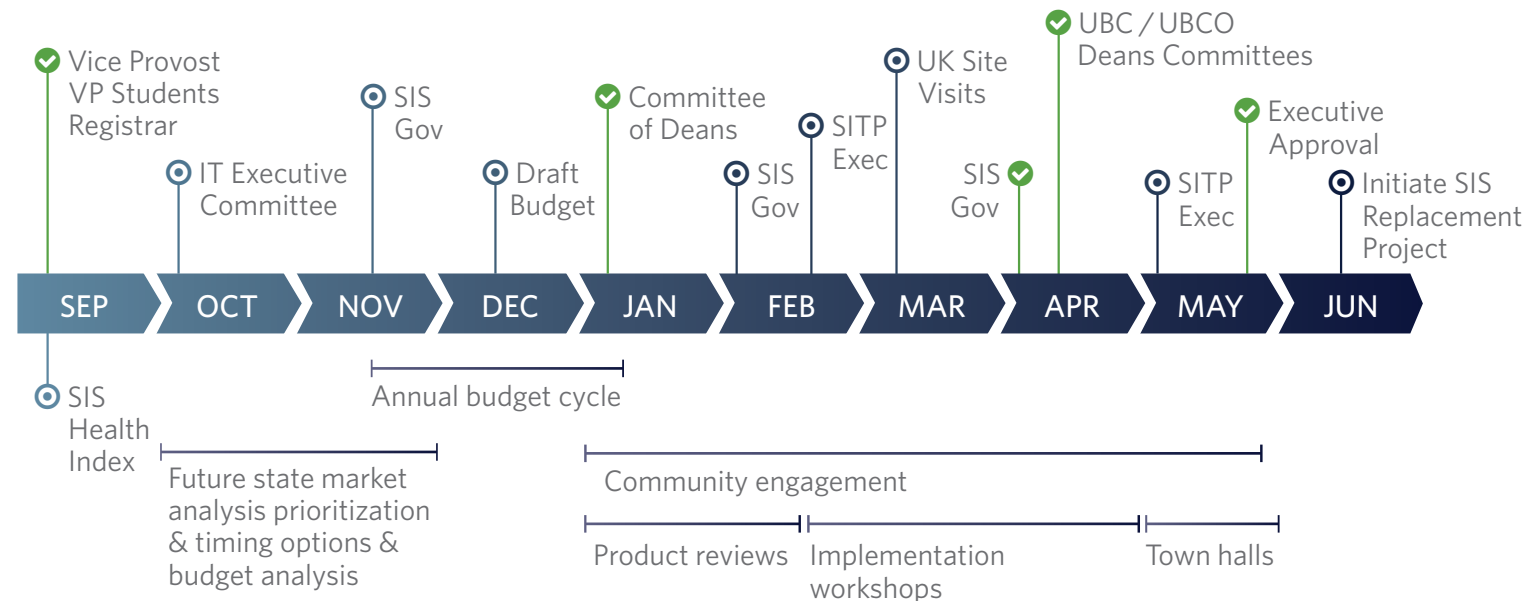
- Additional market and feature analysis
