








2. CRITICAL LITERACY



Teach students to ask questions before, during and after reading

Benefits For Students:

- Develops comprehension and vocabulary
- Enhances listening and speaking skills
- Aids in the development of critical literacy skills

Sample Questions






What does the title tell you about this story?

What do the pictures tell you about this story?


During Reading

They continue building meaning.








Wordless Books
