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How to Complete the SPECO Modules and Health Authority Pre-requisites

Student Practice Education Core Orientation (SPECO)

- 1. See SPECO <u>Quick Reference Guide</u> for LearningHub account set up.
- 2. Register for <u>SPECO Curriculum</u>.
- 3. Complete all requirements for direct/clinical care providers.
- 4. Complete all Health Authority specific pre-requisites.
- 5. It is your professional responsibility to retain proof of completion.

Health Authority Pre-requisites for <u>All Students</u>

PHSA

- 1. Go to the <u>PHSA Prepare for your Practicum</u> page.
- 2. Go to Step 2 complete the <u>PHSA Privacy Module</u> and the <u>Hazardous Drugs</u> <u>Safety Awareness Module</u> on the LearningHub.
- 3. Complete Step 3 read the PHSA Core Policies.

Fraser Health

- 1. Go to the <u>Fraser Health Student Practice Education</u> page.
- Under "Part 2: Confidentiality" complete all 3 steps. To complete step 2, you
 must fill out the Confidentiality Acknowledgment Form and <u>mail</u> it to Fraser
 Health. You will also need to login to the Learning Hub to complete step 3.
 Once logged in, to access the course:
 - a. Go to "My Profile" (down arrow at top right)
 - b. Select "Add another health organization"
 - c. Select "Fraser Health" and "Student"
 - d. Fill in necessary fields
 - e. Ensure the "Fraser Health" profile is active (it can be accessed via the "switch profile" tab via arrow at top right) when starting the course.

Vancouver Coastal Health

- 1. Complete the VCH <u>Confidentiality Undertaking</u>.
- 2. View the VCH <u>professional image guidelines</u>.

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Providence Health

- 1. Go to the <u>Providence Health Student Orientation</u> page.
- 2. Click the "Mandatory Orientation" star icon.
- 3. Under "Part 2: PHC-Specific Prerequisites," complete Step 1 and 2. Note there is a new online <u>Confidentiality Undertaking</u> course which you can take rather than printing and signing the form.

Health-Authority Specific COVID-19 Requirements

- 1. Go to the <u>SPE Orientation and Preparation site</u>.
- 2. Scroll down to the additional learning requirements for COVID-19.
- 3. All students complete the listed COVID-19 learning modules for Fraser Health and Vancouver Coastal Health.
 - a. For Fraser Health, review guidelines
 - b. For Vancouver Coastal, <u>complete 3 modules</u>
- 4. Additionally, NMP students are recommended to complete the <u>Northern Health module</u>.
