# I. ICON IMAGES:

On my **SPLASH** Page I used "Crystal Clear" icons. The *royalty-free* icons for *commercial use* were set free by creator, Everaldo Coelho. They can be used on blogs, websites and other venues. My *Moodle* website uses six icons for quick navigation. The icons effectively represent the purpose of the link. The majority of the time was focused on understanding the licensing agreement. After scouring the web for free icons, I eventually came upon this blog that had a comprehensive list of free and usable icons for commercial and non-commercial websites.
