Flights	The FT MBA P3 February exam period will end on <u>Thursday,</u> <u>February</u> 9 th , 2023 at 10 PM. Do not book flights until after the exam period is completed. International flights require passengers to arrive 2 hours before departure; therefore, flights leaving before midnight on February 9 th , 2023 will not be an option. Missed exams will not be re-scheduled. Be sure to purchase tickets that arrive on location by Sunday Feb 12th . Your ticket to the destination should be for the duration of the program. The program will start on Monday Feb 13th and the <u>last program day in location will be Friday</u> , February 24 th , so you can depart anytime from Saturday, February 25 th . FT MBA students must return to Vancouver before Period 4 begins at 8:00 AM on March 6 th , 2023.
	We highly recommend purchasing trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance and flexible airfare. In the event of a medical emergency, illness, travel advisory from the Canadian Government not recommending any travel, or natural disaster, you could be refunded for some/all of your flight purchase. The type of coverage may vary depending on the policy you choose to purchase. The cost is often determined by the price of your ticket and may range between \$100 – \$150 CAD.
Hotel	Due to the logistical challenges and safety requirements students on GIE will stay at the same hotel in each destination. Booking information will be made available by the RHL Office. You will be notified of the details and costs in the upcoming weeks.
	For the purposes of the GIE, students should apply for a visitor visa for stays less than 90 days.
<i></i>	Some citizens are not required to have visa for entry to South Africa. A complete list can be found <u>here.</u>
Visa Requirements	Visa applications must be submitted in person only, irrespective of where you live. This is not negotiable. Appointment is necessary.
& Type	Visas are not issued the same day and you are required to bring an Express post Canada Post envelope for the return of your passport.
	From 07 February 2022, all applications for immigration documents (Visa and Permits) should be lodged at the South African Consulate General in Toronto.
	Note: The RHL Global Learning Team has collected this information based on the information available to us. You are advised to contact your GIE country Consulate/Embassy (information at the end of this document) to verify your specific visa requirements.

	Processing time is 5 working days if all the requirements are met.
