#### Special Issue for WITS 2022 Best Paper Nominees

The 32<sup>nd</sup> Workshop on Information Technologies and Systems (WITS 2022), was successfully held in Copenhagen from December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022. As announced in the WITS 2022 Call-for-Papers (CFP), *Decision Support System* (DSS) now invites WITS 2022 best paper nominees to submit an extended version of their nominated paper to a special issue dedicated to the workshop. The special issue will share the same theme as WITS 2022 on “Embracing Digital Asset Disruption in the Digital Economy”. Since these nominated papers have already gone through one round of rigorous review at WITS 2022 and are deemed to be among the best papers submitted to the workshop, this special issue offers an excellent opportunity for the papers to be fast-tracked for publication in DSS within 12 months. Each submitted paper to the special issue will, at most, go through two more rounds of reviews (likely one major revision and one minor revision). The special issue aims to appear no later than WITS 2023 in early December.

- Artificial Intelligence
- Blockchain Technologies
- Computational Algorithms
- Digital Asset Technologies
- Information Quality, Privacy and Security
- Intelligent Systems and Technologies
- Non-Fungible Tokens (NFT)
- Token Economics

- Paper submission: April 1, 2023
- First round notification: June 1, 2023
- First round revision due: August 1, 2023
- Second round notification: September 1, 2023
- Final paper due: October 1, 2023
- Acceptance notification: October 15, 2023
- Target publication date: December 1, 2023

#### Submission Format and Guideline

Authors of invited papers need to extend the WITS 2022 version of their paper by crafting out a journal version that addresses the comments received from reviewers at the workshop and meets the bar of DSS. All submitted papers must be clearly written in English and contain only original work, which has not been published by or is currently under review for any other journal.
