CONTENT —

- As a panelist, you will be 'briefing' the class on a specific topic.
- Your task is to become the expert on this topic, and convey the key information in an objective manner to your fellow students.
- Your presentation should provide information that is:
 - *RELEVANT*
 - *OBJECTIVE*
 - *COMPREHENSIVE*

COLLABORATION —

- You should work together with your fellow panelists to ensure that the panel presentations are coherent and complementary.
- Your topics should relate to one another, but do not overlap.
- Finish each presentation with some questions for class discussion. Make sure everyone's questions are different!

TIME LIMIT PER PERSON —

4 MINUTES - PREPPED IN ADVANCE

You can use notes or cuecards for this part.

4 MINUTES - FREESTYLE

Respond to audience questions.

HANDOUT —

- One-page single-spaced handout per person.
- Please include references on a second page (typically 10 to 12 references).
