

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# CFE in a Nutshell

- 3 week volunteer (unpaid) field experience
- Teacher candidate helps partner meet their educational objectives
- Teacher candidate observes, engages, assists, reflects upon, and learns about non-traditional forms of teaching and learning



# Community Field Experience (CFE)

Research finds that "non-formal" educational involvement helps teacher candidates develop a broader, more holistic view of education than practica limited to classroom settings.






#### What teacher candidates say they learned through the CFE 64 students voluntarily reported:




#### Search

In most cases, the community field experience occurs outside of schools in placements hosted by community partners. Some field experiences take place in a school context that is very different from the extended practicum site, and others take place in locations across the province, country and internationally.

By taking part in the CFE, teacher candidates expand their concept of potential learning sites and how they might get involved, either as a career option or as a classroom teacher with an understanding of educational community connections. During the initial registration process, teacher candidates indicate their preference for a community field experience placement by theme or geographic region.



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
