Independent Schools: Some facts

- 76 072 students attend BC independent schools
- There are currently 297 FISA independent schools
- 13% of BC children attend independent schools
- Only 5.4% of the Ministry's budget is allocated to independent schools for operating costs
- Ministry Grants: Group 1 = 50%; Group 2= 35%



Why Independent schools?

- Offer families and students CHOICE
- Over over 60% of FISA schools have a religious affiliation
- Selection of chosen educational philosophy e.g. Waldorf, Montessori, IB
- Choice of local opportunities: special educational needs, extra-curricular, global initiatives, leadership and service learning, special needs, class size, university preparatory education
