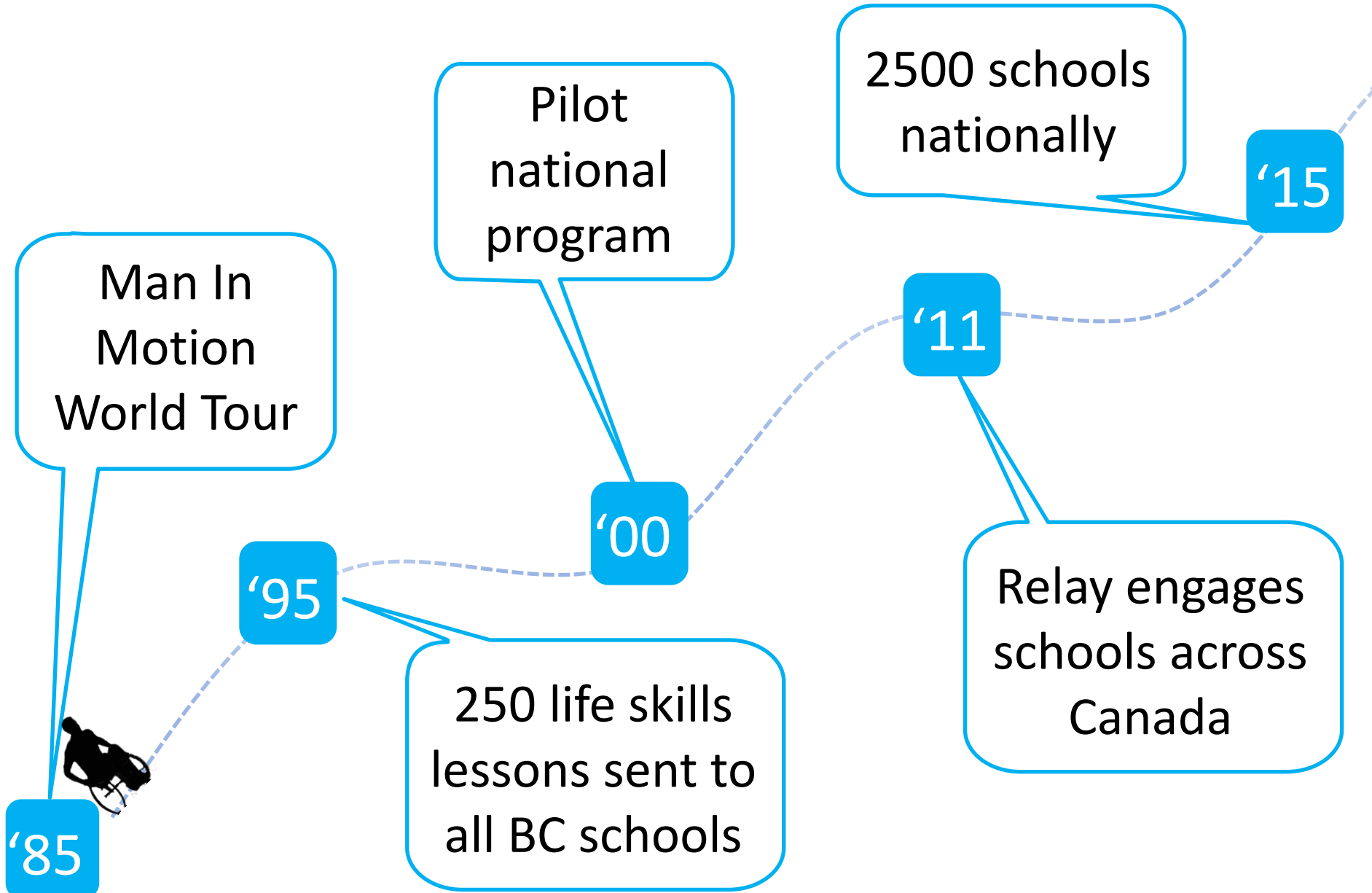

- Connected to provincial curriculum



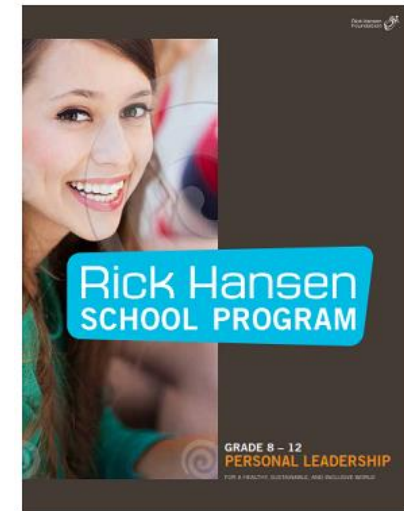

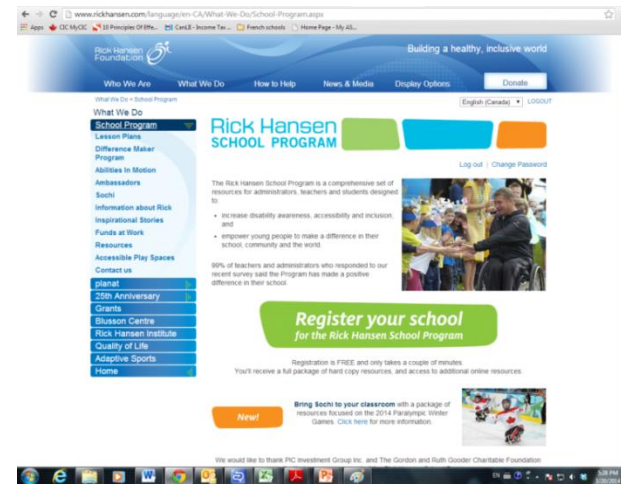
