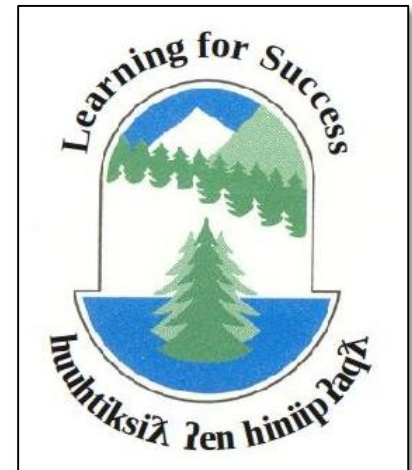


GOLD RIVER SECONDARY

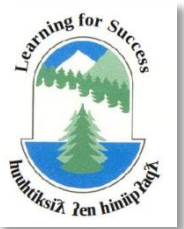

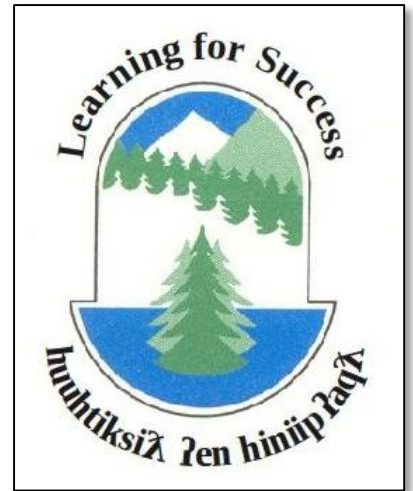
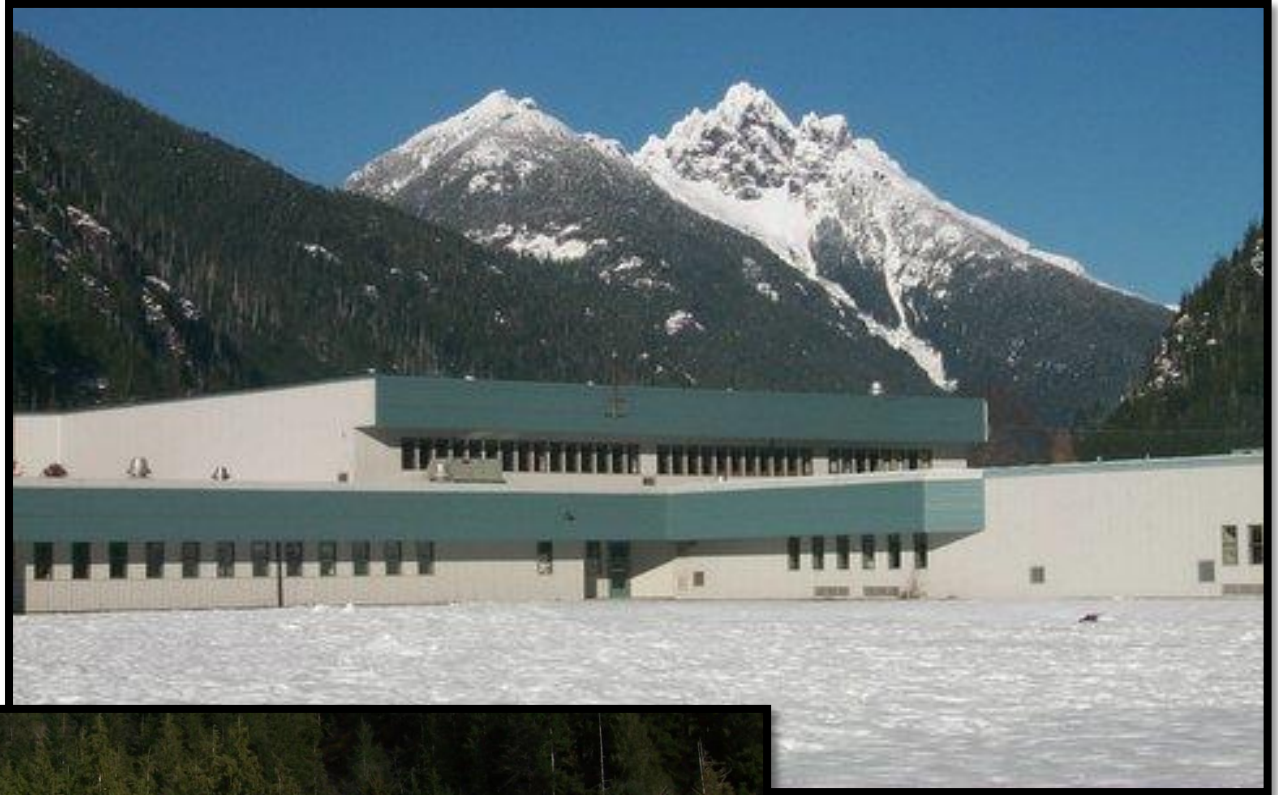


CAPTAIN MEARES ELEMENTARY SECONDARY SCHOOL
