In partnership with our diverse communities, School District 84 will provide all students with a quality education relevant to the demands of modern society.

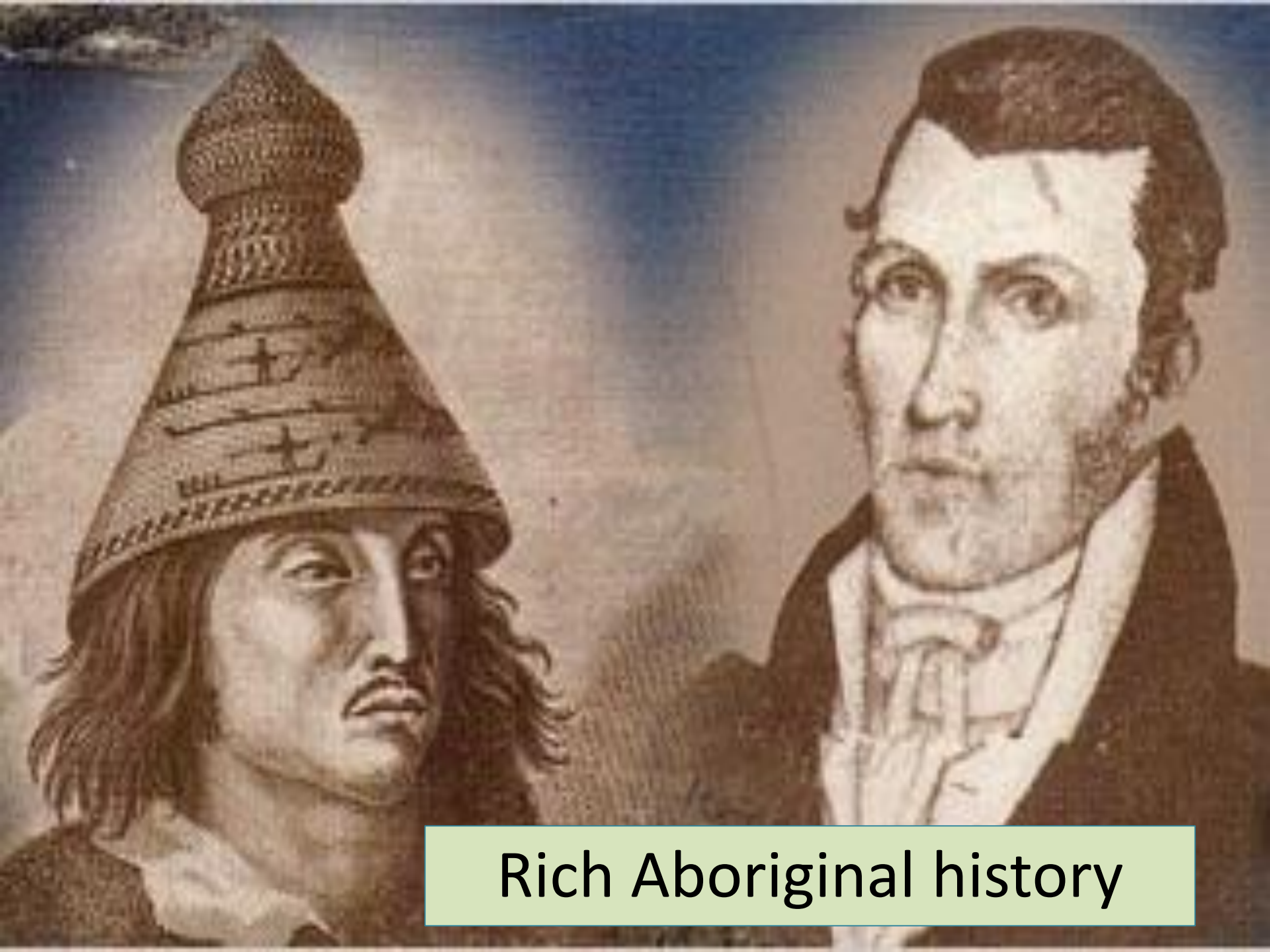

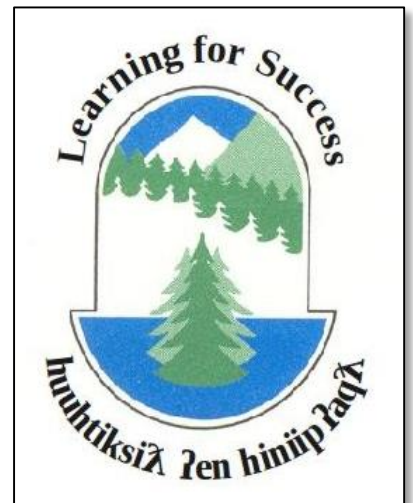
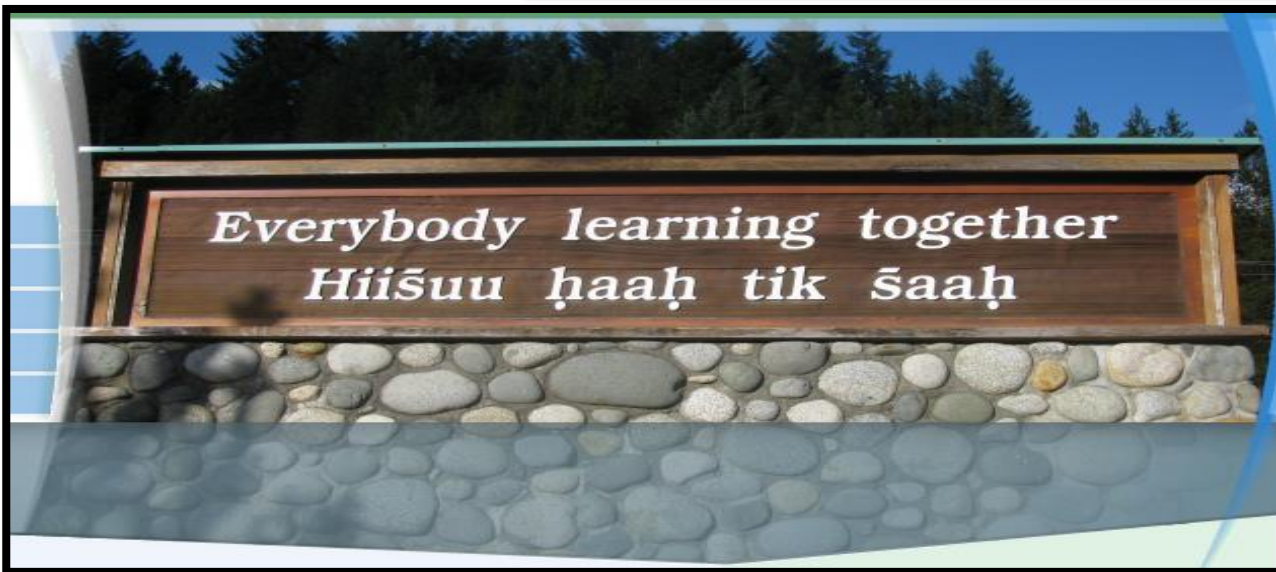


RAY WATKINS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- Focus on Teacher Inquiry and Collaboration

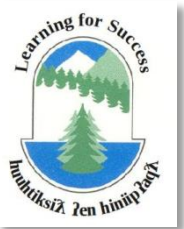

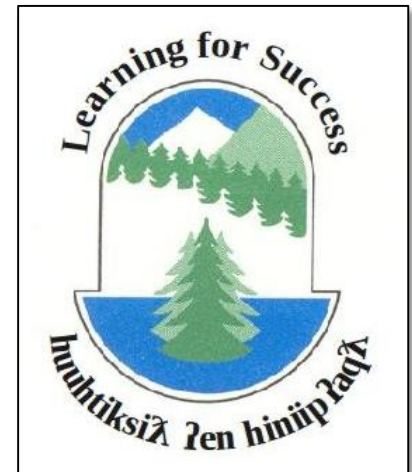


GOLD RIVER SECONDARY

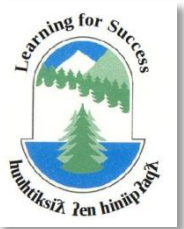

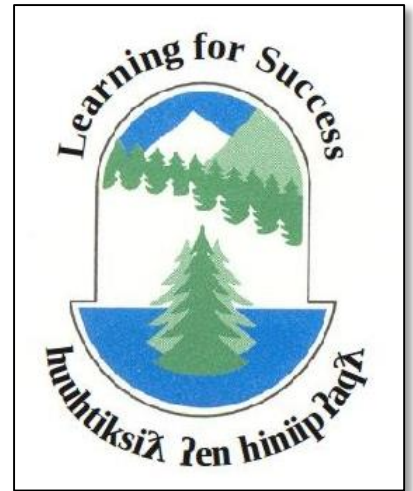
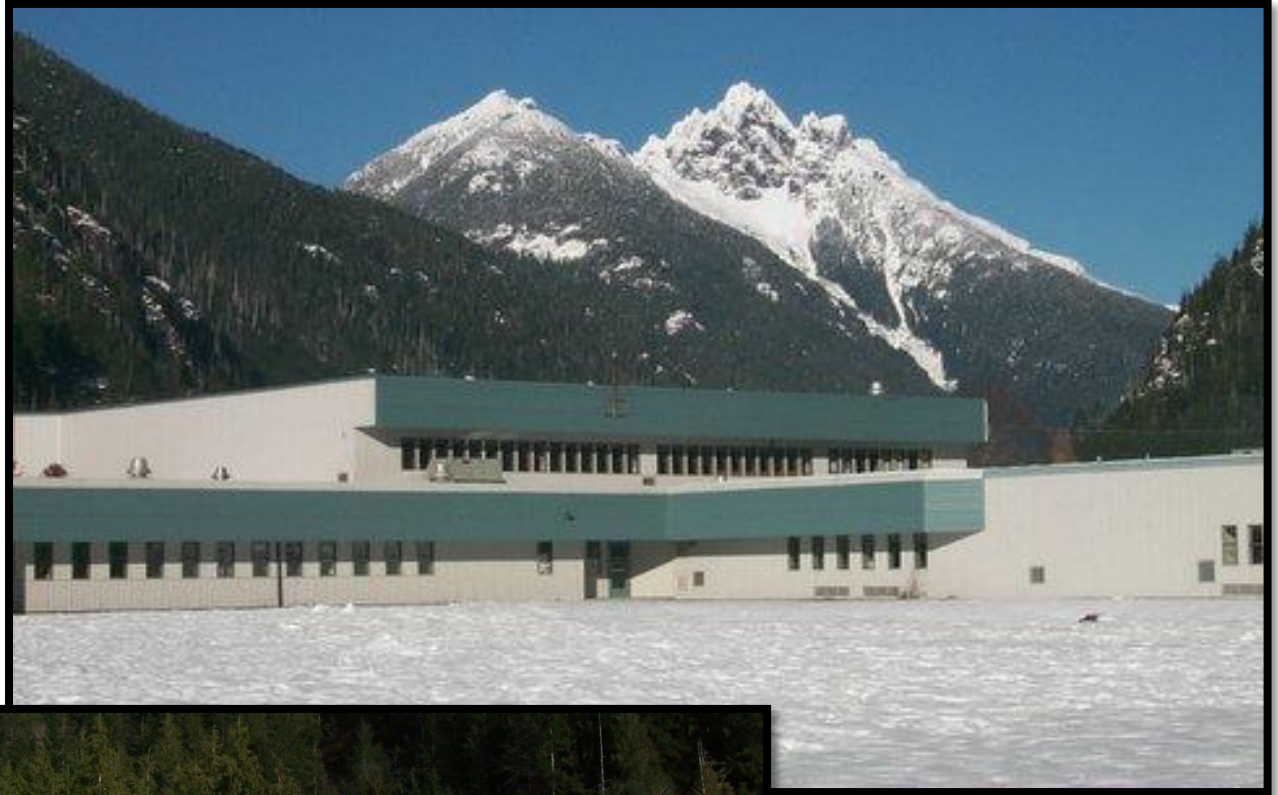


CAPTAIN MEARES ELEMENTARY SECONDARY SCHOOL
