








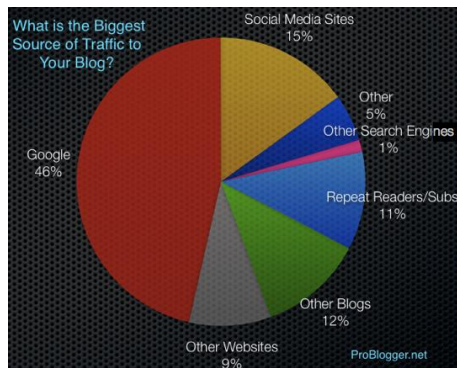



Today I've returned from . I went there for a weekend of fun. Fun includes
