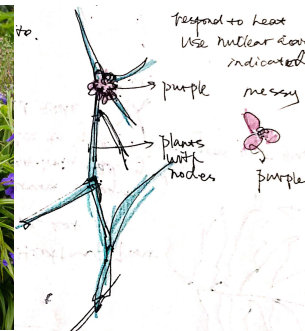


**105. Tradescantia x andersonii      spiderwort      Commelinaceae(L10)**
