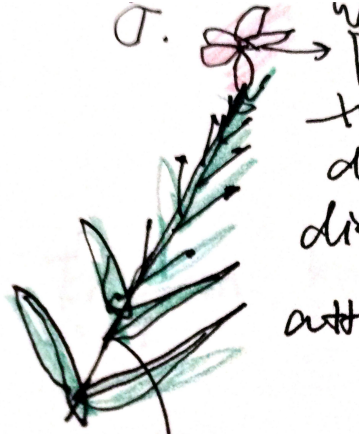


135. Lysimachia ephemerum

willow-leaved loosestrife

Euphorbiaceae(L4)



Basic ID *Vertical presence, gray-green foliage, white flower spikes.*

Zone:5-9

Type:herbaceous perennial

Height and spread:1m/0.5m

Bloom time:summer

Evergreen/deciduous:deciduous

Flower & Fall color: white

Leaf arrangement/Foliage: clumps of gray-green leaves

Flower/cone/fruit description(s):arise slender racemes of small white flowers with mauve-colored veins

Tough: medium

Maintainence: Moderate

Light:Full Sun too Part Shade

Water use: Dry too Medium

Soil requirement: Moist but well-drained,not dry out in summer

Maintenance advice:1.Divide in spring or fall. Seed in containers outdoors in spring

2.Tidy after flowering and cut down dead foliage in late winter or early spring

Disease: Rust, leaf spot
