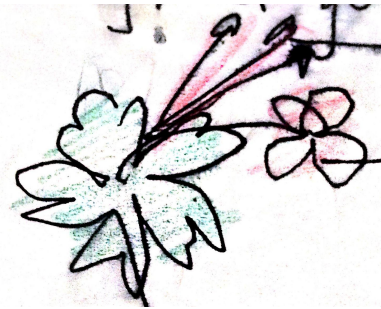


146. *Geranium x cantabrigiense*

Cambridge cranesbill

Geraniaceae(L3)



Basic ID *palmately-lobed leaves, 5-petaled flowers*

Zone: 5-8

Type: herbaceous perennial

Height and spread: 1 feet/1 feet

Bloom time: May to June (late spring into early/mid-summer, sporadic *rebloom* sometimes continuing too fall.)

Evergreen/deciduous: deciduous

Flower & Fall color: white to pink to red to blue to purple

Leaf arrangement/Foliage: palmately-lobed often aromatic leaves

Flower/cone/fruit description(s): White tinged with pink and pink stamens, and 5-petaled flowers

Recommended plant index ****

Common: Ground Cover, Naturalize

Tough: medium

Maintainence: Low

Light: Full sun to part shade

Water use: Medium

Soil requirement: moist but well-drained soil
