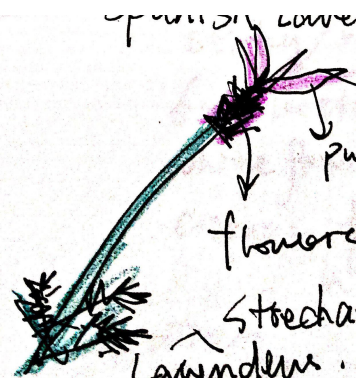


160. *Lavandula pedunculata*
