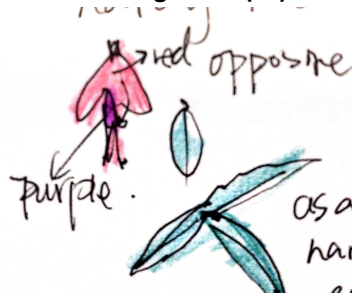


194. *Fuchsia magellanica* 'Little Giant'
