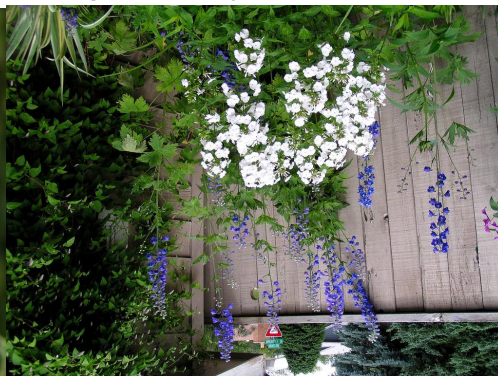


233.Phlox 'Miss Lingard'

Zone:5-10

Type:herbaceous perennial

Height and spread:90cm/60cm

Bloom time:Late Spring/Early Summer

Evergreen/deciduous:deciduous

Flower & Fall color: White/Near White

Leaf arrangement/Foliage:thick-textured narrow leaves
